Note: 30+ will incur additional \$40 p/p

For rural and remote areas the cost will be negotiated.

The **Facilitating Organisation** can cover the costs to provide free training or charge each participant approximately \$175-\$200 for 1 day and \$350 for 2 days (based on 30 participants) to recover costs.

# Who Training is for?

The one day training is for people working with fathers, parents and children including: Men's Behaviour Change Programs, family/domestic violence services, child protection, Aboriginal & Torres Strait Island workers, counsellors, child support workers, teachers, TAFE teachers, police & correctional staff, AOD/Mental Health, and Health services.

The two day Train the Trainer sessions are targeted at professional workers with at least 5 years' experience, and should have skills and qualifications in psychology, social work and counselling.

Participants each receive training resources on a USB pen with Powerpoint presentation, research reports and training resources plus posters, Duluth Wheels, DVD's (Not in my House DVD and Manual) and USB pen to enable training attendees to conduct the START TODAY AGAIN training in their own workplace.
