
PASS THE SALT - IDEAS FOR USE

Pass the Salt questions are fun and meaningful at the same time! They help create connection and stimulate faith conversations. Here are some ideas for how you could use the cards in your community.

- **Kingdom Tables:** Invite 2-6 people to meet at a local coffee shop or in a home and spend 1-1.5 hours using the discussion cards to facilitate life giving conversations. Look out for opportunities to pray with and for one another.
- **Dinner with friends:** Invite some friends and neighbours to your home for lunch or dinner and have Pass the Salt cards available on the table. See where the conversation leads during the meal! They can easily be used with a mix of church and non-church friends.
- **SalvosConnect site:** Help build your connections with community members by setting up some tables, chairs and lounges. Make Pass the Salt cards available on the tables and encourage your volunteers / staff to use them to build relationships and stimulate conversations over tea and coffee.
- **Gathered Worshipping Community:** As part of a corps meeting time, break into small groups of 4-6 and invite each group to discuss their responses to a card. Spend some time praying for one another.
- **Family Store:** At the end of a working day / week, thank and celebrate the volunteers with some food and drink and an hour of relationship building conversation with Pass the Salt.
- **Community of Hope:** Over a community meal or whenever you draw people together, use Pass the Salt as a way to move beyond the superficial and engage in fun and meaningful conversation. This is a helpful and non-threatening way to build community relationships.
- **Small bible study group:** Begin each meeting by reading out a couple of cards and asking each person to share their response. This is a good way to break the ice and move beyond the regular topics of conversation.
- **Youth / Young Adults / Women's Fellowship / Home League / Men's Groups:** Spend a few nights each year using Pass the Salt for variety and to help build relationships.
