SIGNS

SOMEONE MAY BE EXPERIENCING MODERN SLAVERY:



- 
- Forced to work under threat or coercion, or under harsh conditions.
 - Tricked or trapped into work or providing services.
 - Recruited or transported through force or deception.
 - Not having control over other parts of life. e.g. where and when to eat, sleep or rest, or freedom to leave.
 - Not having control over the work, when work can stop and/or nature of the job is not what was intended.
 - Forced to work to pay off an unreasonable debt or one that never ends.
 - Working with little or no pay.
 - Pressured, forced or tricked into getting married against your will, or when underage.

* Children under the age of 16 without a safe guardian cannot be assisted by the ARP and will be referred to child protection and the Australian Federal Police for support.
