Increase sense of social justice

- Opportunity for a sensitive, facilitated conversation about social hardship.
- Encourages empathy as students 'see outside themselves' through service.
- Encourages recognition of diversity within the student's community.

Bring curriculum to life

- **Business/Marketing** students could create promotional videos to raise awareness and engage other students to support the Red Shield Appeal.
- Student groups could develop a social enterprise to learn enterprising skills and have the proceeds donated to The Salvation Army.
- Teach Project Management by encouraging students to run an event such as a school barbecue, sleep-out or fun run in support of The Salvation Army.
