



HUNT THOSE EGGS!

Everyone loves an Easter egg hunt on Easter Sunday morning. But why not add a sporting twist to the search for those yummy choccy eggs this Easter? Check out these cool ideas to add even more fun to the hunt!

EASTER EGG RELAY

Break into two teams. Send the first team member off to find the first egg. When they find one, they race back to their team and the next person sets off to search for the next egg. The winning team is the one who finds the most eggs within a set time, or the team that finds a certain number of eggs the quickest!

EGG AND SPOON RACE

Competitors line up at a start line with an Easter egg and a spoon each. Each person places their egg onto their spoon then places their other arm behind their back. On "Go!", racers rush to the finish line as fast as they can without the egg rolling off the spoon. If the egg falls, you have to go back and start again! First over the line wins.

RAINBOW EGG HUNT

For this you need eggs wrapped in lots of different coloured foil. When the hunt begins, instead of finding a certain number of eggs – or as many as you can! – the goal is to find one of each colour that's been hidden. For example, you might need to find one red, one green, one blue, one purple, one gold and one silver. Could be tricky!

BUNNY PAW HOPSCOTCH

After eating lots of Easter eggs and hot cross buns, you might have some extra energy to burn! Grab some white chalk and head outside. Create an Easter hopscotch grid on a concrete area by drawing bunny paws instead of squares and numbering them from 1 to 10. Hop your way through the game – just like the Easter bunny!
