Critique behaviours and contextual factors that influence the health and wellbeing of their communities (ACPPS098)	 information on the impacts of domestic violence and marginalisation in relation to homelessness identifies role of families, friends and community organisations in supporting young peoples wellbeing

AD: Alcohol and other drugs	 explores link between homelessness and use of alcohol and drugs increases understanding of impact of drug use on individuals
FN: Food and Nutrition	- exploration of economic influences on food choices
RS: Relationships and sexuality	- information on violence as a cause and effect of homelessness
MH: Mental health and wellbeing	 explores peoples varying experiences of homelessness to promote understanding of individual diversity explores community supports available
