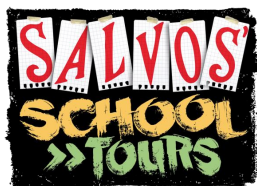

<p>Evaluate factors that shape identities, and analyse how individuals impact the identities of others (ACPPS089)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - explores impact of social isolation, poverty and homelessness - explores stereotypes of homelessness - provides definition and statistics related to homelessness in Australia - discussion on causes of youth homelessness - explores impact of 'sleeping rough' on individuals wellbeing
<p>Examine the impact of changes and transitions on relationships (ACPPS090)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - provides opportunity for students to express opinions, thoughts and beliefs
<p>Investigate how empathy and ethical decision making contribute to respectful relationships (ACPPS093)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - describes decision making experiences related to homelessness - explores how financial restrictions influence choices
<p>Critique behaviours and contextual factors that influence the health and wellbeing of their communities (ACPPS098)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - information on the impacts of domestic violence and marginalisation in relation to homelessness - identifies role of families, friends and community organisations in supporting young peoples wellbeing
<p>AD: Alcohol and other drugs</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - explores link between homelessness and use of alcohol and drugs - increases understanding of impact of drug use on individuals
<p>FN: Food and Nutrition</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - exploration of economic influences on food choices
<p>RS: Relationships and sexuality</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - information on violence as a cause and effect of homelessness
<p>MH: Mental health and wellbeing</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - explores peoples varying experiences of homelessness to promote understanding of individual diversity - explores community supports available
