Factors leading to difference in the experience of being young	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Explores impact of poverty as a form of disadvantage - Information on the impacts of domestic violence and marginalisation - Identifies role of families, friends, education settings and community organisations in supporting young people's wellbeing
Reasons for categorisation of youth and consequences of homogenous thinking about youth and adolescence, including stereotyping, prejudice and discrimination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Explores stereotypes of homelessness (including likely sources of stereotypes) - Explores causes of youth homelessness
