Brene Brown, social researcher and motivational speaker, introduced me to her concept of the 80/20 rule being the key to a successful marriage. She talks about how the old expectations that marriage should be a 50/50 relationship, is not at all realistic or doable.

Brene's 32 year relationship with her husband Steve, whom she shares two kids with, whilst its been the hardest thing she has ever done, she credit's its success (in part) to the 80/20 rule.

"What we do is we quantify where we are, so if Steve comes home and is like I've got 20 (in terms of energy, patience and kindness levels) I'll pull the 80," Brené explained in her chat with Tim Ferriss in his podcast The Tim Ferriss Show.

Another example might be Brené coming home from looking after her sick mum to tell her husband "I've got 10," aka, 10 per cent energy, kindness and patience.

The idea is, if either of them report back as having less than a combined 100, they will know that's a sign they need to sit down and figure out a plan of kindness towards each other.

I have been really challenged by this concept, and see it extending far beyond marital relationships, to become a really powerful picture of what the body of Christ can be for each other.

I have started talking about this in my teams- if any of us come in and for whatever reason, whether it be the demands of our roles, family, mental health, you name it, we come in and all we have to give is 10%, it is a very brave thing to share that with others. It is then on the team, on the wider body of Christ, to take on the other 90%. And vice versa. And sometimes, there are days when we are all not doing ok. A three person team might come in and all be at 10%. We don't have the capacity within ourselves or for each other. It is so important then that we be upfront as a team, and like Brene says, we sit down and work out a plan of kindness toward each other.

What a powerful picture of the body, lifting each other up and carrying each other when a member of the body is not strong enough to carry themselves!

I'm so grateful for the days where I have come in with nothing, and others, out of love for Jesus and love for me, have lifted me up, supported me, and carried my load. It is my privilege to be there to do the same for others.

Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves. Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. (Romans 12:10-11)
