A STUDY THROUGH THE BOOK OF COLOSSIANS



How do you introduce yourself to people? What do you say?

How do you introduce Jesus to people? What do you say?

Read Colossians 1:1-14

What stood out to you? What encouraged/puzzled or bothered you?

What does this passage say about God and people?

What does this passage say to you about who Jesus is and who you are?

Which words were emphasised, repeated or connected in this passage?

In verses 3-14 Paul begins by thanking God. How can we cultivate gratitude, thanksgiving and praise in our prayer life and in our conversations with other people?

The church is portrayed as a grace receiving and grace giving community (v2,7,8). How does the gospel help us be a grace giving community?

We see a connection in this passage between faith in God and love for one another. How does your relationship with God help in your relationships with people in your life?

This week write a list of things you're thankful for and write out your testimony of how the gospel of grace was shared with you, how you saw your sin and turned to faith in Jesus

Pray for open doors and boldness in sharing the good news about Jesus
