How would you answer someone who genuinely asked “who is Jesus?”

In what area of your life or situation has it been toughest to put Jesus first this week?

Read Colossians 1:15-23

What immediately stands out to you? Does anything in this passage particularly confuse you, encourage you or convict you?

We’re all tempted to try and earn, add to or pursue something beyond Jesus. What happens when we begin to believe Jesus isn’t enough?

What things do people look at or search for to find meaning and hope apart from Jesus?

What are one or two ways in which your life is different since you were changed from being alienated from God to being reconciled through Christ’s death?

How does it feel to know that you’re presented “without blemish and free from accusation” before God because of Jesus?
