Today we begin a new series that focuses on others. The following thoughts are excerpts from morning devotions with Chris Witts found on the Hope 103.2 website.

I recently read this quotation which I liked: “Most human problems stem from the fact that we treat people as things and things as people”. How many problems arise because people are not treated properly or fairly? Relationships can easily disintegrate when this happens, and you may know of situations like this. Not everyone gets on with others, and we have misunderstandings and conflict.

We can be guilty of careless and hasty words, treating others harshly and inappropriately. Mothers used to say to their kids, you must respect others because if you don't, they won't respect you. It's true, even though we don't hear that advice very much these days. We expect others to show us respect all the time, and yet we can be slow in giving it back.

Unfortunately, our world has taught us to look out for number one—ourselves. But the Bible teaches us to assist others and defer to others above ourselves. When we don't do it God's way, things don't work. “Treat others as you want them to treat you. This is what the law and the prophets are all about” (Matthew 7:12). When Jesus came, he loved people and showed them respect and courtesy—even his enemies. He was a great role model.

We read in 1 Peter 3:8-9 these great words, “Finally, all of you should agree and have concern and love for each other. You should also be kind and humble. Don't be hateful and insult people just because they are hateful and insult you. Instead, treat everyone with kindness. You are God's chosen ones, and he will bless you”.

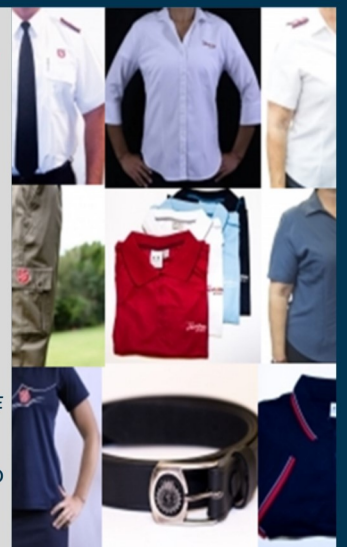

Songsters Chris has made the decision to step back from the leadership of the songsters. We thank Chris for 14 years of leadership with the group and know that he will continue to use his gifts to glorify God. There have been discussions, thought given to and prayer for the future direction of the songsters. No decision has been made at this point in time but it will be communicated with the members of the songsters once it is made.



The Salvation Army's response to the national bushfire disaster is in its fourth month. To date, we have distributed 80 per cent (\$8.4m) of the \$11m in funds that has been received. Over \$43m has been pledged to The Salvation Army since launching our Disaster Appeal on 9 November 2019.

Money that has been raised during this period will be spent or committed by June 2020 to the immediate and longer-term recovery of those affected by the 2019/2020 bushfires.

The Salvation Army Emergency Services (SAES) teams have been active in the bushfire crisis since September 2019 with more than 3000 staff and volunteers active.

We have provided over 250,000 meals and over 240,000 light refreshments and personal packs to first responders and evacuees.

Our personnel and mobile units continue to remain on the ground, providing immediate financial and emotional assistance, a hand of friendship or a listening ear. Twenty six staff are currently supervising a dedicated telephone line for financial assistance and have assisted 2,850 people.

We thank the Australian community for its support. Our Community Engagement and Emergency Services teams are continuing to work with federal, state and local partners in disaster response and recovery plans to map out the steps ahead.
