In the modern calendar, we label all years with B.C. (before Christ) or A.D. (anno domini, or "in the year of our lord"). The birth of Jesus has become a defining moment for separating history – what life was like before Jesus and then what life is like after Jesus.

The Christian life is also defined by what life was like before Jesus and life after Jesus. In Ephesians 4: 17-32, Paul writes to the Christians reminding them of their new life in Christ. He reminds them of the way of life that Christ has unfolded within them and that a deep experience of Jesus – of salvation – will be seen in the way they live out their lives alongside others.

God does a work of transformation in us – if we are willing and allow Him to do His work.

When we accept Jesus as our Saviour and we allow Him to become Lord of our lives, then we've had a change of heart and if our heart is different, the way we act and speak towards people should be changing for the better also. The good news is that we don't have to do the changing on our own – it is the Holy Spirit at work in us on a daily basis. We have many opportunities to bless others. We have many opportunities to live out of transformed lives.

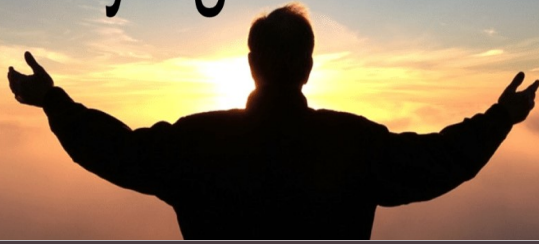
