



Following Christ means making disciples. His words echo in the back of our minds, “Go therefore and make disciples (Matthew 28:19). Not first and foremost “have daily devotions” or “give to the poor,” but make disciples. We don’t become a Christian by making disciples, but once we are in Christ, few things come closer to capturing the heart of our calling while we’re still here on earth.

The reality, though, is that we have always been involved in disciple-making, even from birth — just not always disciple-making for Jesus. You are a disciple. The question is: Who are you following? You have disciples. The question is: How are you influencing the people watching you?

Discipling is a ministry of how, but it should be even more so a ministry of why. Discipling others absolutely involves modeling faith and godliness with our lives (Philippians 3:17), but effective discipling also imparts the reasons for believing in and living for Jesus (2 Timothy 2:2).

You will follow, and you will lead and teach. What will be the legacy of your life and example among the people in your life who outlive you? “When you step out of the hallway of this life into the room of eternity, what will you have left behind in the lives of others?” Will we leave behind a bright, but fading image of ourselves — our gifts, our interests, our successes — or a bold and lasting image of Christ leading to eternal life?

## Sunday Meetings

A reminder of the changes that are in place and we all need adhere to, so that we are compliant with both Queensland Health and The Salvation Army regulations:

- Physical distancing – staying 1.5m apart from people who are not a part of your immediate family
- We are able to sing
- No handshaking or hugging
- Hand sanitizer to be used on entry
- In order to maintain the 4 square metre rule people will be seated in both the downstairs and gallery of our hall allowing a capacity of 85 people
- It is necessary for you to provide contact details upon entering the building, there is QR codes located around the entrance which link you a website to enter details.
- There will be a limited number of musicians participating on the platform at any one time in order to maintain the 4 square metre rule
- You will need to exit the hall once the meeting is finished and not mingle in the foyer or on the stairs
- At this stage coffee and chat will not be recommencing
- Bring your own bible as there are not to be communal books available
- We will continue online meetings as well as in person at BCT
