“All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit...” (Acts 2:4 NIV)

After Jesus did his work on the cross and rose from the dead, he said to his followers, in essence, “You’re going to turn the world upside down, but you can’t do it without the Holy Spirit working in you.” On the Day of Pentecost, the Spirit came, filling them with power, and the church was born.

You may think we don’t have to wait anymore, because the Spirit has already been given. But sometimes God has to make adjustments in us; sometimes he has to convict us of sin and of the pride that can easily arise in us. As we wait and worship, just as the early disciples did, the Holy Spirit will fill us anew and do his work in us, so that we can go in the name of Jesus and be a blessing to people.

Think about it: The Lord entrusted all of his kingdom work to guys who weren’t trained, so that they would have to depend on the Holy Spirit. They only knew how to fish and now they were preaching, so they knew they needed the Holy Spirit. So do we.

Lord, come and do a deeper work in me, filling me, and taking control of my life. I know that you love me, and I’ve had experiences with you; but I want a deeper experience. You promised it for us, and now I want you to fulfill it in my life.

Thank you, Lord. In Jesus’ name I pray, Amen!

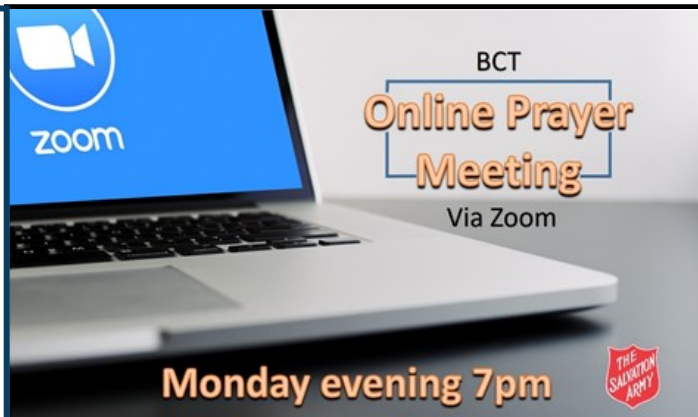
If you are looking for a group during the week where you can connect with God and connect with others, then we have a few that may be suitable for you

Sunday Meetings

A reminder of the changes that are in place and we all need adhere to, so that we are compliant with both Queensland Health and The Salvation Army regulations:

- Physical distancing – staying 1.5m apart from people who are not a part of your immediate family
- People from different households are to sit apart
- No handshaking or hugging
- Hand sanitizer to be used on entry
- There will be seating available both downstairs and in the gallery allowing a capacity of 94 people
- Provide contact details upon entering the building, using the QR code located at the entrance or you can give your details to one of the team at the door.

- There will be a limited number of musicians participating on the platform at any one time in order to maintain the 4 square metre rule
- You will need to exit the hall once the meeting is finished and not mingle in the foyer or on the stairs
- At this stage coffee and chat will not be recommencing
- Bring your own bible as there are not to be communal books available
- We will continue online meetings as well as in person at BCT

WICKHAM TERRACE CAR PARK

Located between Wickham Terrace and Turbot Street, Spring Hill

Cost \$5 for four hours on Sunday

POST OFFICE SQUARE CAR PARK

223-235 Adelaide Street, Brisbane

Discounted rate \$6 with ticket validation in our foyer

KING GEORGE SQUARE CAR PARK

Vehicle entry is via Roma or Adelaide Streets and exit is via Roma Street.

Cost \$5 for four hours on Sunday
