During his third missionary journey, the apostle Paul met a group of disciples in Ephesus who knew more about John the Baptist than about Christ or the Holy Spirit. Paul challenged them to put their trust in Christ, for whom John had prepared the way. So they were baptized in the name of Jesus. Then, as Paul prayed over them, they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, "and they spoke in tongues and prophesied."

In some ways, we too are like those disciples. We may know a lot about church doctrines. But can we honestly say that our lives have been profoundly touched and transformed by the power of the Holy Spirit? Do we lead victorious lives over sin in our daily walk with the Lord?

If our answer is no, then we need to listen to the apostle Paul speaking to us today.

We need to be filled with the Holy Spirit. Let us open ourselves to the Holy Spirit. Let us open our hearts and invite the Spirit to fill us with his presence and power.
