Where's home for you? Often after asking a person their name our next question is to find out where they live. No matter what place you call home, the very word strikes a chord deep inside each of us. Home means sanctuary, the place we can rest, relax, enjoy time with family & friends, learn, grow and just be. Our homes say a lot about who we are and what we think is important in life.

In the parable of the lost son, Jesus tells of a young man who chooses to leave home and go to another place taking his inheritance with him. After some time, and some hardship and lack of money, he comes to the realization that it is time to return home to his father, although he doesn't believe his father would want to receive him as a son. The father has been waiting and watching every day for his son to return home. The day he sees him coming, the father runs to greet him and to welcome him back home.

Jesus tells this parable to say that you and I have a home in God. When we're lost, it's because we have strayed from the place we were meant to be. Jesus actively looks for those who are lost and brings them home. Our true home is with God — it is in relationship with God through Jesus. There are many who are lost — some don't even know they are lost — but Jesus is bringing them home to a father who loves them.

You and I can partner with Jesus and be part of the reason someone comes home. Being found is simply coming home and finding our roots again or for the first time. As we live love to the people around us, God will use us to show his love and to welcome those who come home.

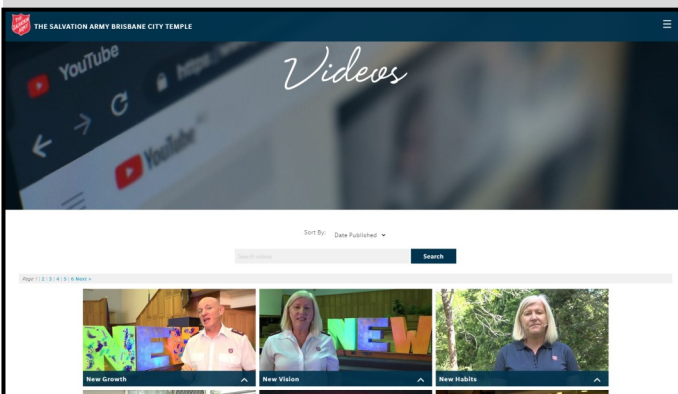

Located between Wickham Terrace and Turbot Street, Spring Hill

Cost \$5 for four hours on Sunday

POST OFFICE SQUARE CAR PARK

Discounted rate \$6 with ticket validation in our foyer

KING GEORGE SQUARE CAR PARK
