## Looking through the book of Nehemiah

### **They worked together.**

All through Nehemiah 3 you read about the people who worked next to each other building the wall and repairing the gates. A lot of people were involved – working on their designated part of the wall. Nehemiah had so marvelously organized this that each one had a section of the wall or a gate assigned to him. They helped one another.

### **They worked near their home.**

Each person worked on a section of the wall near their own home. This is God's design for ministry. God has placed us all strategically where He wants us to be. In our community, at work, at home we each have a ministry. That is why God put you there.

### **Each person completed his assigned task.**

They kept on until they had finished the work. Some had more to do than others, but no one failed--except the nobles of Tekoa who would not dirty their hands.

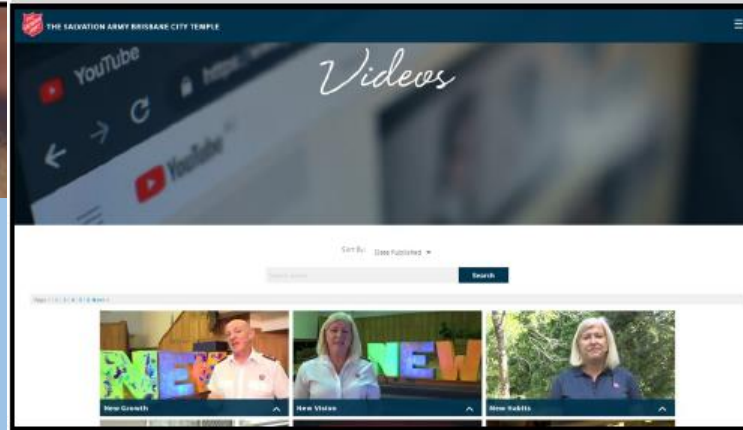

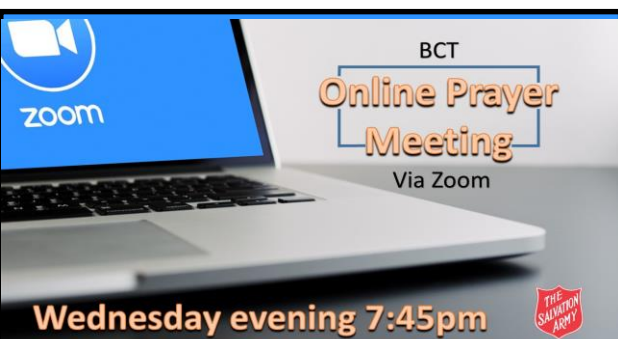
