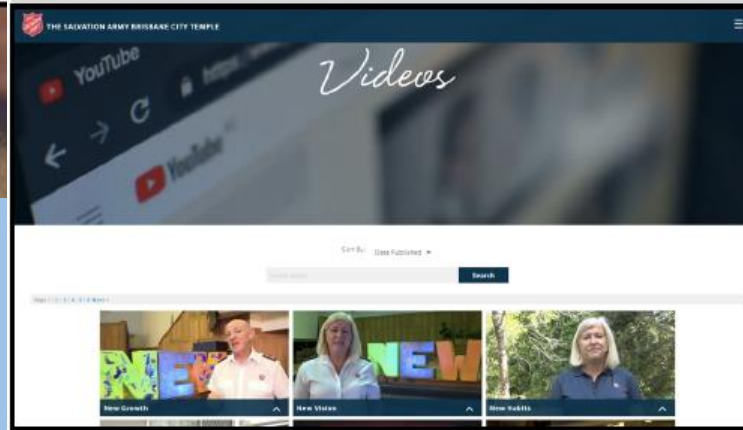

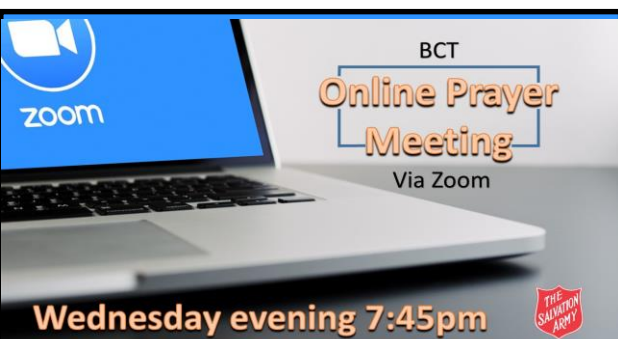

Ticket sales close 12.00 noon, Wednesday 26th May 2021, or until sold out.

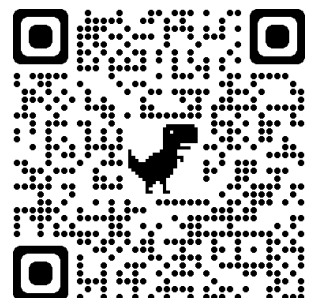
