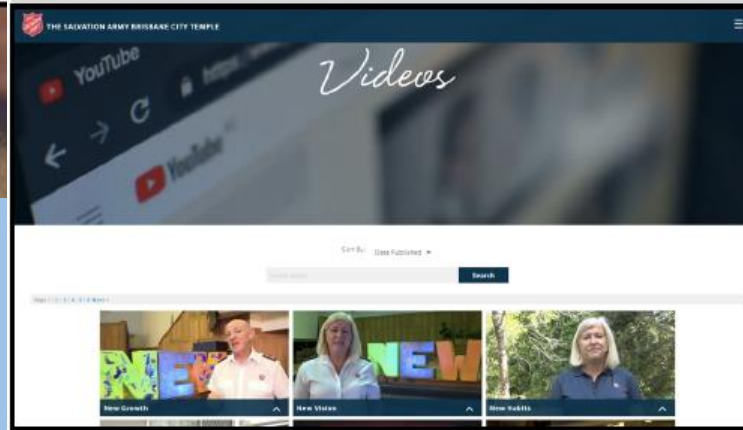

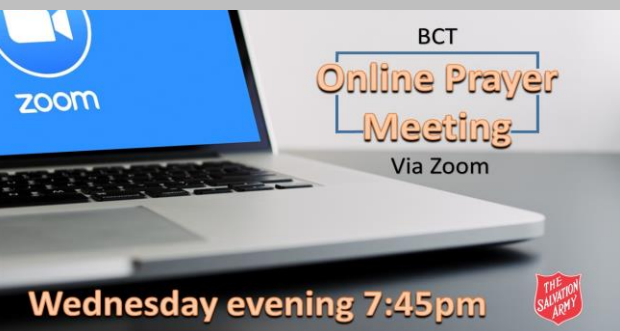

Ticket sales close 12.00 noon, Wednesday 26th May 2021, or until sold out.

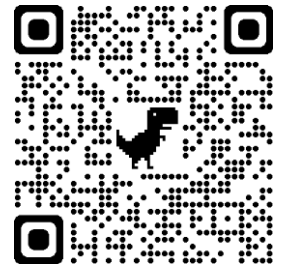

# Rebuild

Looking through the book of Nehemiah

This weeks reading is Nehemiah 5

Nehemiah was a man of character, who clearly understood the principles of God's kingdom. Chapter 5 tells how Nehemiah stopped the people from collecting interest from their fellow Israelites who were struggling to survive, a practice forbidden in Deuteronomy 23:19–20. Nehemiah also tells that he was careful not to personally profit off the people while governor. He didn't even collect the governor's allowance for food, as the governors before him had, because he knew it would be too much of a burden on the people.

Nehemiah never heard Jesus' words in his lifetime, but he certainly practiced them: 'If anyone desires to be first, he shall be last of all and servant of all'" (Mark 9:35) Nehemiah became great by being a servant to all.
