Looking through the book of Nehemiah

This week's reading is Nehemiah 8

During this past week we celebrated the life of Col Crawford. A life well lived in relationship with his Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Reading the bible daily was important to Col. More than that was the knowledge that it was God's word and Col applied what he read to his life – to the way he lived.

It was Col's desire when he went to be with the Lord for his family to read a particular portion of Scripture. He left written instruction for them to do that as he wanted them to know and remember what God has done for them through Jesus Christ in bringing people into relationship with himself.

Col knew the importance of the Bible for his life. A legacy he left for his family

The Bible is literally "God-breathed" (2 Timothy 3:16) -God's very words to us. There are so many questions that philosophers have asked that God answers for us in Scripture.

What is the purpose to life? Where did I come from? Is there life after death? How do I get to heaven? Why is the world full of evil? Why do I struggle to do good?

In addition to these "big" questions, the Bible gives much practical advice in areas such as:
What do I look for in a mate? How can I have a successful marriage? How can I be a good friend? How can I be a good parent? What is success and how do I achieve it? How can I change? What really matters in life? How can I live so that I do not look back with regret? How can I handle the unfair circumstances and bad events of life victoriously?
