Commitment is a four-letter word for Christians

LOVE

Our relationship with God and acceptance by God isn't based on our being committed to Him, but His being committed to us. And that commitment flows from His great love for us. When God wants to grow our commitment, He doesn't start with our commitment, He starts with our love. Jesus said, if you love me, you'll keep my commandments. He also said that the first and greatest of the commandments is to love the Lord our God with all our heart, mind, soul, and strength. All the law and prophets hang on that commandment and loving our neighbour as ourselves. If our commitment is flagging, the answer isn't to prop up our commitment but to stir up our love. This order is vital because while love always leads to the right kind of commitment, commitment doesn't always lead to the right kind of love.

Probably every one of us would admit that our commitment level isn't where it should be. And maybe some of us, if we're honest, would admit that we are more committed to doing the right stuff and believing the right stuff than we are to loving Jesus. Whether our problem is that we lack commitment, or that our commitment is lacking love, God's answer is to realign our hearts to His again, to take us back to that love we once had for Jesus. Crazy love. Radical love. First love.

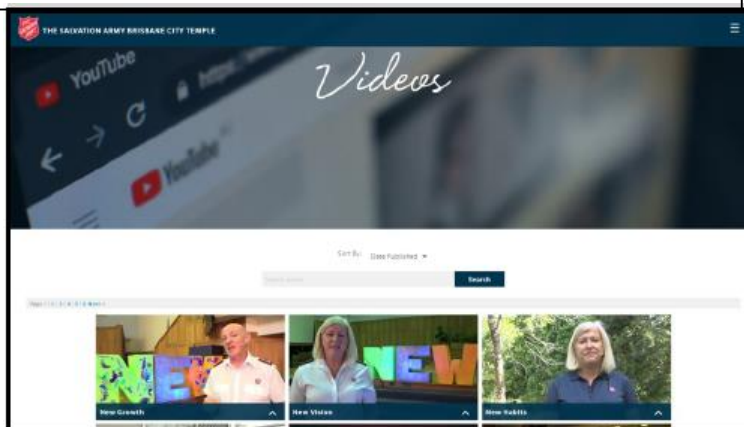
