## Bunnings – 9<sup>th</sup> December

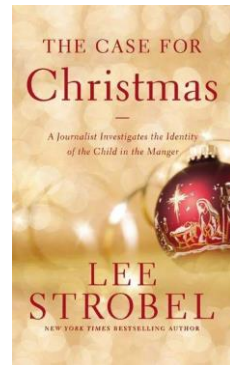
The Indooroopilly Store will be holding a Family Christmas event with a place for customers to donate wrapped gifts that will be donated to the Salvation Army.

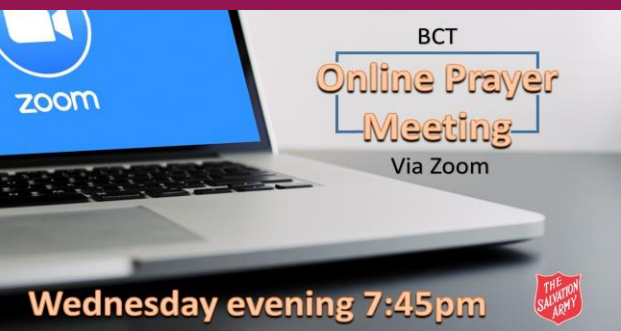
