- Leaders survey

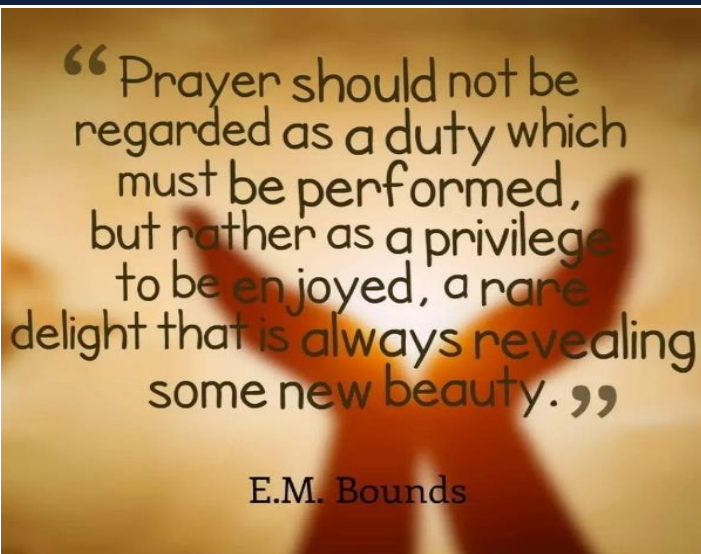
The survey's will be available at the back of the hall. All survey's require the following Church Code – **SA370400**

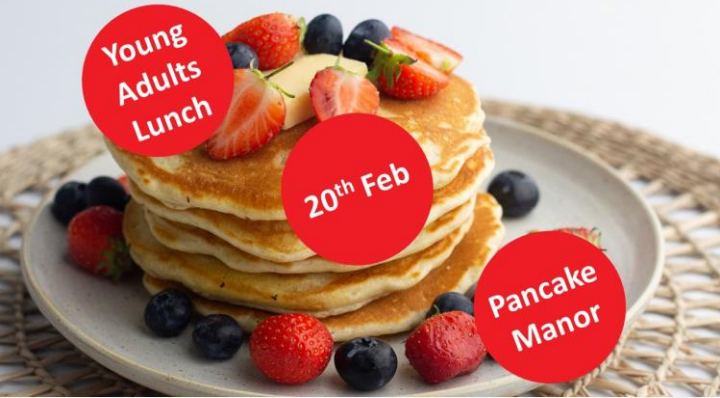
