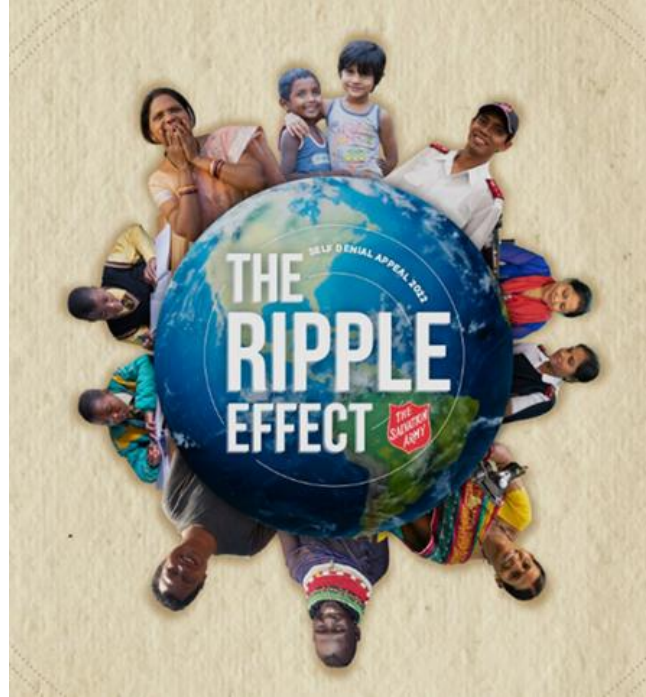

The Self Denial Appeal started in 1886 when General William Booth called Salvationists to give sacrificially and to deny themselves so that they could offer God's love to a hurting world.

The theme for the Self Denial Appeal 2022 is 'The Ripple Effect'. It reminds us that small actions taken in Christ's name can become big, life-transforming outcomes for the Kingdom of God.

When you give to the Self Denial Appeal you can choose to give your gift to mission support OR community development.

Mission Support funds are non-tax-deductible. They support welfare initiatives and build the organisational strength of The Salvation Army in developing countries. Examples include the provision of church halls, residences for officers, computers and training.

Community Development donations are tax-deductible and only support community development projects. Examples include projects for poverty alleviation, clean water and microfinance.
