The 2022 Red Shield Appeal campaign focuses on family and domestic violence as a means of telling the stories of people who have experienced a personal crisis and connected with The Salvation Army. Through this connection, they have then accessed a wide range of support that has helped them address the immediate issue of violence in their lives and the flow-on effects. This includes financial hardship, homelessness and addiction.

Last year alone, the Red Shield Appeal donations provided support and care to people in need, on almost 1.9 million separate occasions and this year we aim to raise \$36 million from 4 April to 30 June 2022 to continue to provide support to those in hardship across our nation.
