World Day of Prayer is a worldwide ecumenical movement of many faith traditions who come together to observe a common day of prayer each year on the first Friday in March. Throughout the entire day, people collectively pray all over the world, beginning with the first sunrise and ending at the last sunset. Coordinated services of Christian worship and prayer



are held across the world in over 170 countries, directed by the international body – the World Day of Prayer International. The program for the service is prepared well in advance by women from one focus country of the world. Each service has an advertised theme and involves Bible readings, prayers and songs and a reflection and is attended by women and men.

The 2023 Brisbane City service will be held at Brisbane City Temple on Friday 3rd March at 10am.

A number of dignitaries will be in attendance including Her Excellency the Honourable Dr Jeanette Young AC PSM, Governor of Queensland and her husband Professor Graeme Nimmo RFD.

The guest speaker will be Lieutenant Colonel Olive Lucas. Morning tea will follow the service.




Australia Day
