

Pentecost Challenge: Five Names, One Mission

In Acts 1:8, Jesus gives His disciples a world-changing mission—to be His witnesses in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and beyond. It’s a big call, but He doesn’t leave them hanging. He promises the Holy Spirit will empower them—and us—to carry it out.

Fast forward to today: your Jerusalem might look more like your workplace, your neighbours, your gym buddy, or the barista who knows your coffee order better than your name. But the mission remains the same. You are part of God’s beautiful story of redemption, and He wants to breathe His Spirit into you afresh (John 20:22)—not just to shine brightly for Him, but to step into someone else’s story with love, hope, and maybe even banana bread.

So here’s the challenge: ask God for five names—people you know who don’t yet know Him. Pray for them every day between now and Pentecost Sunday. Let’s see what the Holy Spirit might do when we show up, pray up, and speak up.

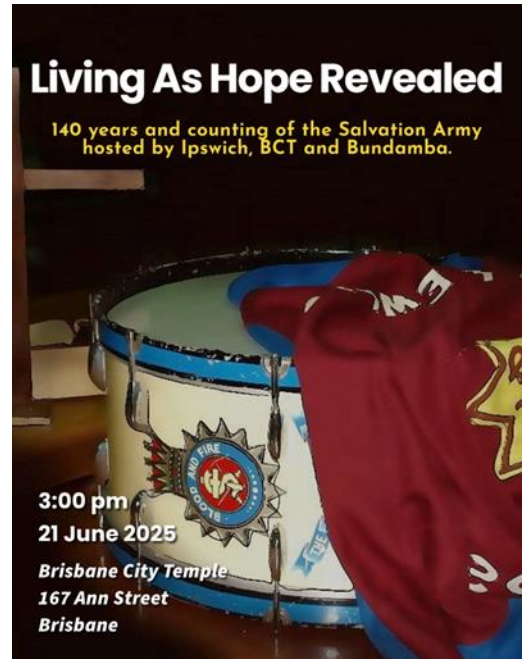

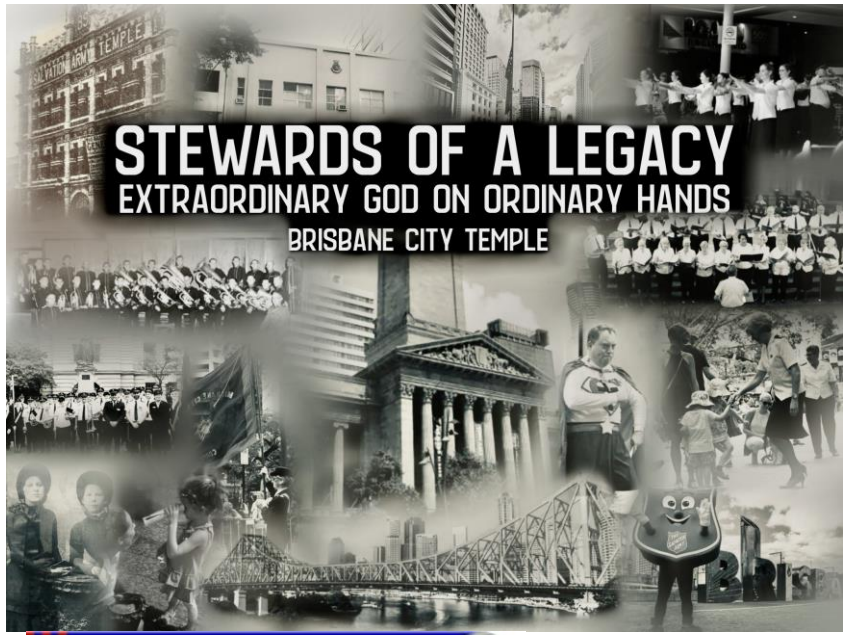
