| 1 | Icebreaker             | Share about a time when something completely unexpected happened in your life—big or small. How did you react, and what did you learn from that experience?   |
| 2 | Reflecting on Miracles | <p>Which story from the message (Taria Pitt, the friend's pregnancy, Elijah and the prophets of Baal) stood out to you the most? Why?</p> <p>Have you ever witnessed or experienced something you'd consider a miracle or an answer to prayer? Would you feel comfortable sharing about it?</p> |
| 3 | Barriers to Faith      | <p>The message highlighted three things that can stop us from having faith: not listening, not looking, and not speaking. Which of these do you relate to most, and why?</p> <p>What are some other things that can get in the way of your faith or trust in God?</p>                           |
| 4 | Seeing God at Work     | <p>How do you usually notice God working in your life or in the lives of those around you?</p> <p>Are there ways you can become more attentive to what God is doing—through listening, looking, or reading His Word?</p>  |

In the story, the bull was chosen as a sacrifice which was the same image used to represent Baal, the idol worshipped by many people at the time.

What are some "idols" or things people put their trust in today, and how might God be inviting us to turn our attention back to Him?

Elijah made it harder for God to "show up" by pouring water on the altar—what does it look like for you to trust God even when things seem impossible?
