Scripture

"A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another" (John 13:34-35).

Reflection

Jesus commanded us to "Love one another" (John 13:34). When we love one another, we recognise the struggles of others and show love by transforming their situation. We show the love of Jesus by speaking up for injustice in the world. Advocating for social justice is another way to show the love of Jesus. It is not enough to just ease suffering and pain - we are called to fight the unjust systems that cause suffering and pain. We work for justice because the God loves justice and people flourish best in a world that is fair and equitable. If all people are of value, then we must act in ways which ensure justice and equality for all. This means addressing unjust social systems through advocating for justice with government, business and the wider community. This includes raising awareness of injustice and actively working alongside others for a more just world.

Prayer

Lord, grant us a vision of your world as your love would have it: a world where the weak are protected, and none go hungry or poor; a world where peace is built with justice, and justice is guided by love. Give us the inspiration and courage to build it. Father, may we live out the words of Proverbs 31:8-9, which compel us to 'speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, protect the rights of those who are helpless. Speak out and pronounce a sentence of justice, defend the cause of the wretched and the poor.'
