DOORWAYS VOLUNTEER POSITION:

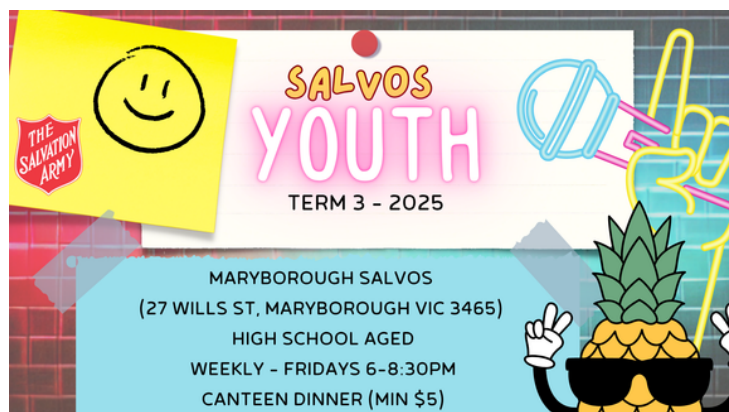

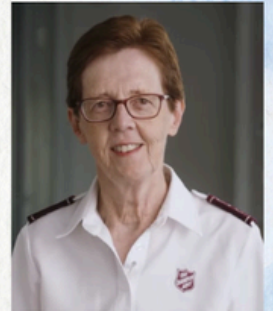
