THE PRINCE OF PEACE IS BORN

We are now entering into the 2nd week of Advent. There are many reading we can do individually or as a worshiping community. The candle lite is know as the Peace Candle or the Bethlehem Candle (purple).

Peace come which Jesus brings to our hearts and to the world. We are reminded of the preparations made in Bethlehem for the arrival of a Saviour. His birth was humble, in a stable. There was no fanfare, no flashing lights, just the quiet breeze on the night. · Isaiah 9:6-7 - "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the LORD Almighty will accomplish this."

We read Isaiah and as you light the Peace Candle, focus on Jesus who is the Prince of Peace. His peace that surpasses all understanding and remains with us regardless of life's challenges. This week of Advent, will invite you to prepare your heart, just as Bethlehem was prepared for Jesus. Open you heart for God's peace to come into your life and your relationship with Him.

The birth of Jesus is found in Matthew and Luke of the bible. I encourage you to read the story. In Matthew 2 is the visit of the Maji and the escape to Egypt. Luke 2 there is a more detailed account of His birth. The visit of the shepherds, the heavenly choir, and Jesus coming to the temple. As you are reading look for something in the story which you haven't seen before. Ask: what would it be like to be a shepherd, or one of the wise men.

Ask the Holy Spirit to speak to your heart as you begin your reading. Write and share you finding with others in your worshiping community, your neighbour, or family members.

PRAYER:

Dear Father God, thank you for sending you Son, Jesus as our Prince of Peace. I know I have read the story of Christmas for so many years now. However please open my heart to something new, fresh, exciting and full of truth. The birth of Jesus is a miracle. Why did you choose Mary and Joseph? Why did the shepherds hear the good news first?

I can have so many questions, but LORD I am reminded in John 1

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God, in the beginning.

You Son Jesus has always and will always be there. Together we come and celebrate. AMEN.

across the territory.




The Hope of Christmas is a series of devotionals designed to help young families connect with each other and with God during the Advent season.

Millie was a member of Bendigo corps. Please pray for her family






