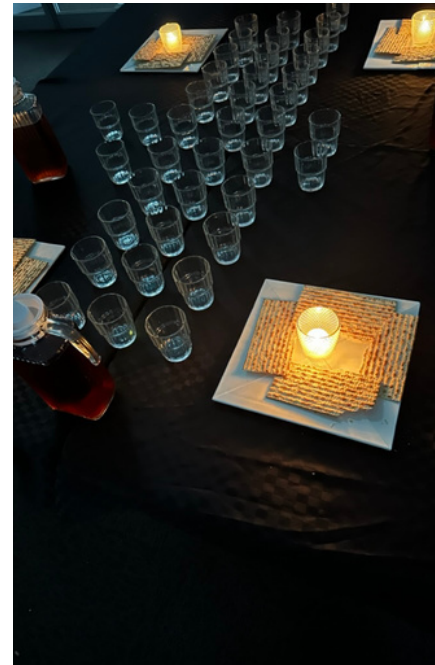

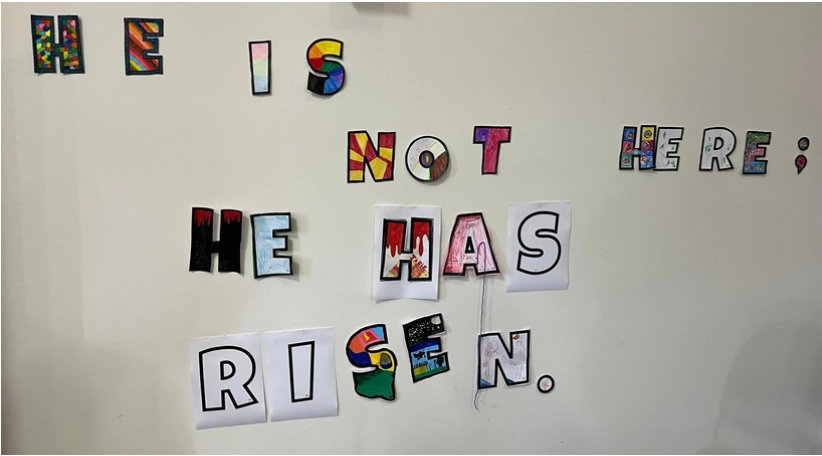
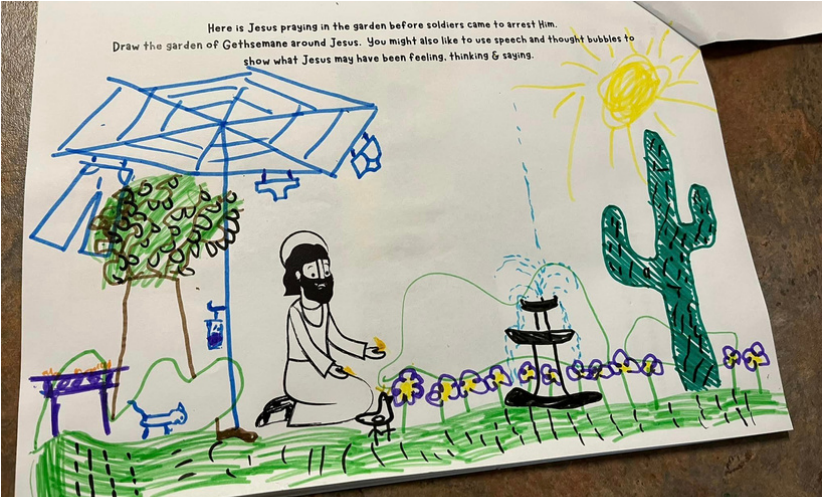
You will continue to hear more and more about Central Vic Salvos as time goes on but at this time I would like to say Thank you for all that you do in serving God as well as supporting and loving people.

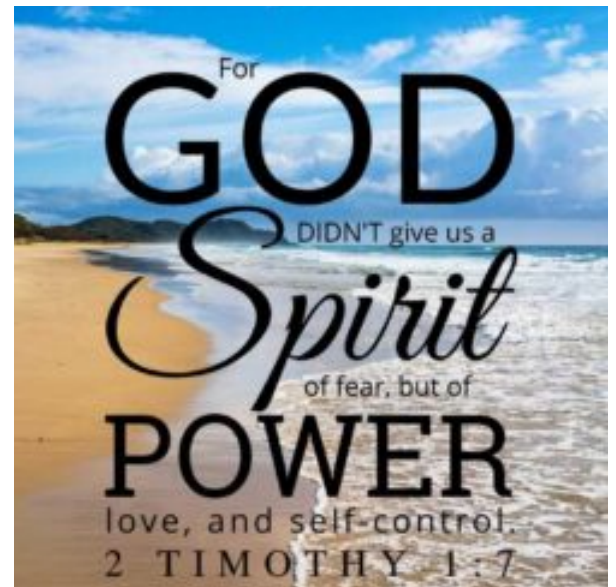
