BRAVO JUST BRASS CASTLEMAINE

In March, Castlemaine Salvos (Vic.) hosted a special concert featuring awesome brass music from The Salvation Army's Melbourne Staff Band as well as members of the Just Brass program.

Just Brass is a Salvation Army program that provides free brass music lessons to children in local schools and communities. "We currently have 32 children in the program," said Castlemaine Just Brass co-ordinator Dean Curtis. "We provide lessons during school hours and have band practice after school on Mondays. "It's always very rewarding to watch a child play their first notes."

The Just Brass musicians had been preparing for quite a while and their performance was a hit with family and friends in the audience. "We played two pieces with the Melbourne Staff Band that our students could play – 'Dem Bones' and 'The Muffin Rhapsody,'" explained Dean.

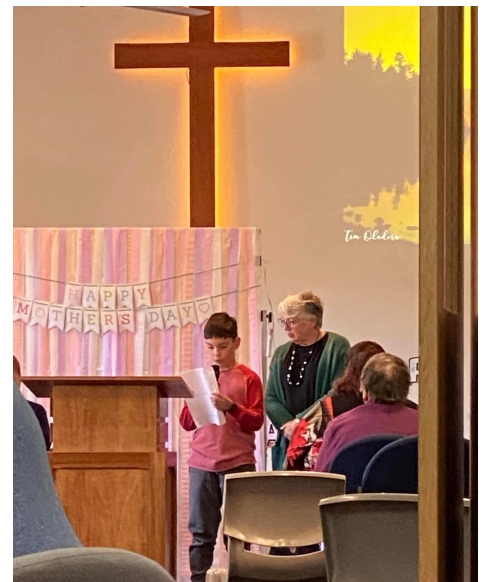
