## Toilet Block

Imagine using a dirty toilet, with a roof that leaks during the rainy season and nowhere to wash your hands. When you buy a toilet block, you are providing the facilities that will help to improve the health and hygiene of children and their family, as well as giving them increased safety and security immediately, and long into the future.

At each Club children receive health education (e.g. HIV/AIDS), as well as learning about child rights and the effects of early marriage. Your gift of Kids Club Resources will provide one Kids Club with essentials like stationery, games and balls, and enable children to learn as they play.

## Child School Supplies

In many low-income communities, a child who does not have basic stationery often can't complete their lessons, write notes, or take part in classroom activities, so miss out on learning opportunities. A few essential items — like pencils and exercise books — can help open the door to education, giving a child the tools they need to learn, grow, and build a brighter future.

### Chicken

One chicken can change a life – starting with better nutrition. With up to 200 eggs laid per year, and the ability to sell chicks and eggs, the family will have a sustainable food source, and an income that can be the start of a thriving business. This life-changing gift also includes vaccinations to help ward off dangerous diseases, and initial food for the chicken.

### Small Business Starter Kit

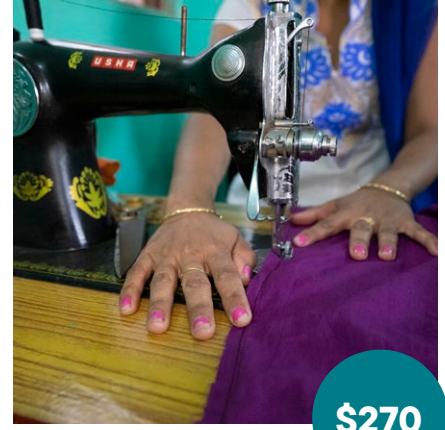

A long-term recovery plan is put in place to empower a survivor of human trafficking and reduce her vulnerabilities to future trafficking attempts. You can give an at-risk girl two days of training in an income-generating activity. She'll learn skills, like entrepreneurship, life and vocational training, such as farming, agriculture, sewing or hairdressing, all leading to resilience and financial security.

### Goat for a Family

A goat can provide delicious nutritious milk for a family. The milk is used for drinking and cooking, and any excess is sold. The goat's manure is used to fertilise the garden so that the quantity and quality of vegetables increases, resulting in more food for the family to eat and sell. Better nutrition, improved health as well as increased income makes this a valuable gift.
