If you give online, still fill out a giving envelope and bring it to church so you can participate in the act of giving. Just write on your envelope that you deposited your gift into the church account and write your name.

Development work is tax deductible whereas evangelical work is non-tax deductible. The Appeal will be open till Sun 28 April.
