

## Who do we support?

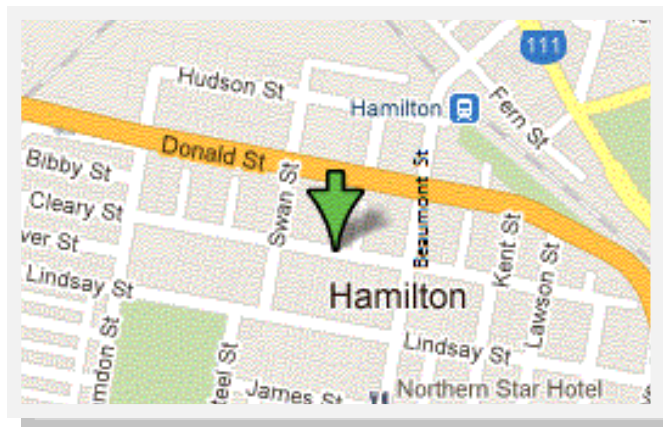

## How does the program work?

The program operates by referrals either through self referral or through agency referrals. Once a referral is received, clients are contacted within 24 hours and an initial appointment is organised for one of our caseworkers to meet with the client. At this initial appointment a drug and alcohol assessment is conducted and a case plan implemented.

## For families of someone living with Drug and Alcohol problems

For families, parents, husbands, wives, partners or siblings who are suffering the effects of Drug and Alcohol use within the family environment, NBYF can offer you crisis support, family mediation, interventions and ongoing follow up to support you through this difficult stage.
