SALVOS CALLED TO SUPPORT INDONESIAN EARTHQUAKE AND TSUNAMI RECOVERY

As you may be aware, The Salvation Army Australia has launched the Indonesian Earthquake and Tsunami Appeal.

Over 1700 lives have been lost on the island of Sulawesi, but there are fears that thousands more are buried in the rubble. People are still searching for their loved ones and emergency workers have refused to give up searching for survivors.

The Salvation Army has a significant presence in the hardest-hit city of Palu and is responding to the need. Here is what we know:

- Power stations and mobile phone towers have been disabled
- The Salvation Army Woodward Hospital in Palu has been damaged but is still providing vital care
- Fresh water, food survival kits, medical supplies and shelter are urgently required
- Transport to move supplies around the city and to remote areas is needed
