If you want to make a difference in the lives of the needy and vulnerable people in our community here is your opportunity! By taking part in the Appeal you will assist in collecting the funds needed to provide help for those in our society who are doing it tough. Funds raised will help disadvantaged people without discrimination, including the hungry, homeless, abandoned or abused. \$60 helps provide a food hamper; \$107 pays for crisis accommodation for a homeless person for one day; \$750 provides a safe place for one week for a person fleeing a family violence situation.

Parramatta Corps has been involved in the Red Shield Appeal from its beginning and this a heritage we are proud of and want to continue. So, if you are not sure where you can assist in the Appeal please see Sharon or Major Barry Fischle. We have included more Community Collection Points this year for those who can no longer assist in the doorknock. We have started collecting at Westfield Parramatta and this Saturday [Federal Election] will be at 5 Polling Sites. Next Thursday night we hope to be at Bankwest Stadium before the Parramatta Eels play the Penrith Panthers, collecting at the gates.

We would love as many people as possible involved in serving our community through the Red Shield Appeal. 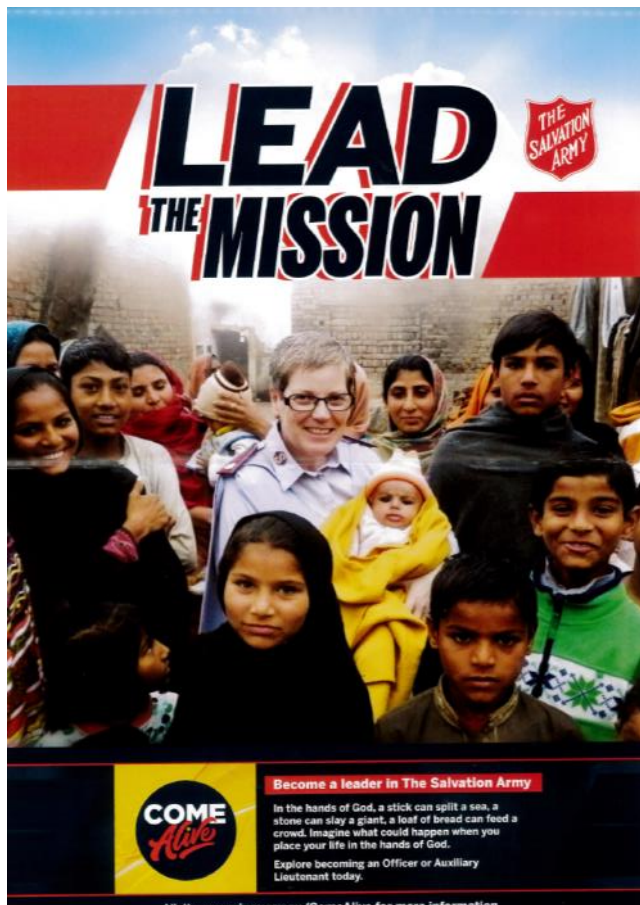
