### THE SALVATION ARMY BAND

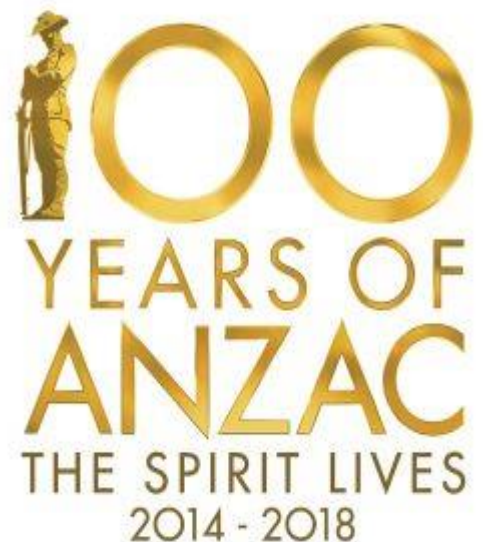
