engineering a holy culture

Every church has a culture. Culture is sometimes defined as 'the way we do things around here'; the way we behave, the things we do, the things that matter, the things that don't matter. Some cultures are healthy, some are not. Most are somewhere in between. On the surface churches can look the same but often they will feel very different. North Brisbane Salvos is not the same as Northlakes, Parramatta is not the same as Perth Fortress. That's because despite appearances we'll see different behaviours and different places will have different priorities. This is true in any organisation whether it's a school or a business.

A helpful way to visualise this is lily. We'll call it the culture lily. On the surface are **Artefacts**. They are visible and physical: the doctrines and the vision statement on the wall; the newsletter with the corps program. Less obvious are **Behaviours**. These are our actions and our non-actions; warmly greeting the newcomer, or not. Lifting our hands in worship, or not. Deep down and often invisible are our **Convictions**. These are deeply held values that are often unspoken and assumed. And it is these that drive our behaviours often times in spite of the artefacts.

One of the priorities in creating a healthy culture in our corps is a knowing, agreeing on, and committing to our central convictions. This Sunday we will turn to Paul and his letter to the Romans to help us on the important task of building a healthy culture.

I've always loved the Church and my biggest desire is to serve Jesus and build His kingdom.



SAFE SALVOS AWARENESS WORKSHOP
