## SKIP BIN CLEAN UP

On Saturday 10 February 2018 between 0800 and 1200, there will be another Working Bee at 34 Smith Street. We have a supply of plastic tubs, packing boxes & materials ready to go. All you need to do is see Martin Bust & he will give you the supplies needed.

When you are packing, you need to pack two ways:

- **SAVE** – Items that are used on a regular basis for use at interim locations.
- **STORE** – Items for which immediate access is not required & will be stored offsite from interim locations.

A sticky label with the appropriate box/item details, with the either **red** or **yellow** dot should be placed on the box/item. If there are any items that are not packed and/or labelled, they may be thrown out.

There are moving manifests that will need to be completed, so that a record is kept of how many boxes/items each group/section has & what is in those boxes, along with details of the items.

Once items are packed, they will be stored in the Jum until moved. We will have another skip bin which will be located on the gravel parking area. This will mean that there will be restricted parking on that space over the weekend. So that there will be spaces available for mobility & parents with prams parking on Sunday 11 February; please keep the concrete ramp spaces free for this purpose. We apologise for any inconvenience this will cause on the day.

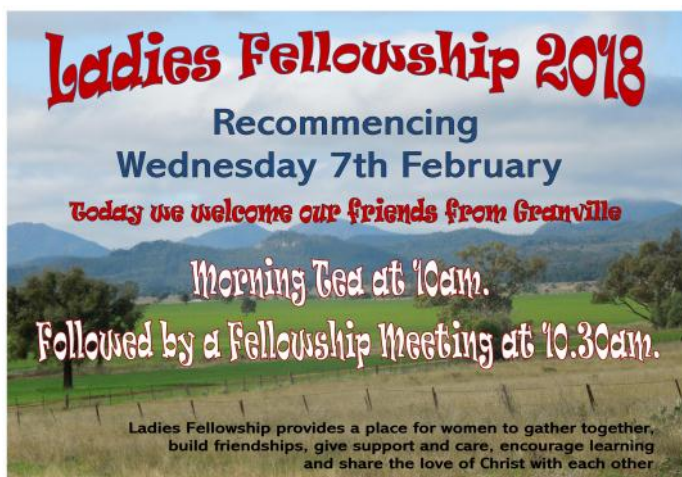
