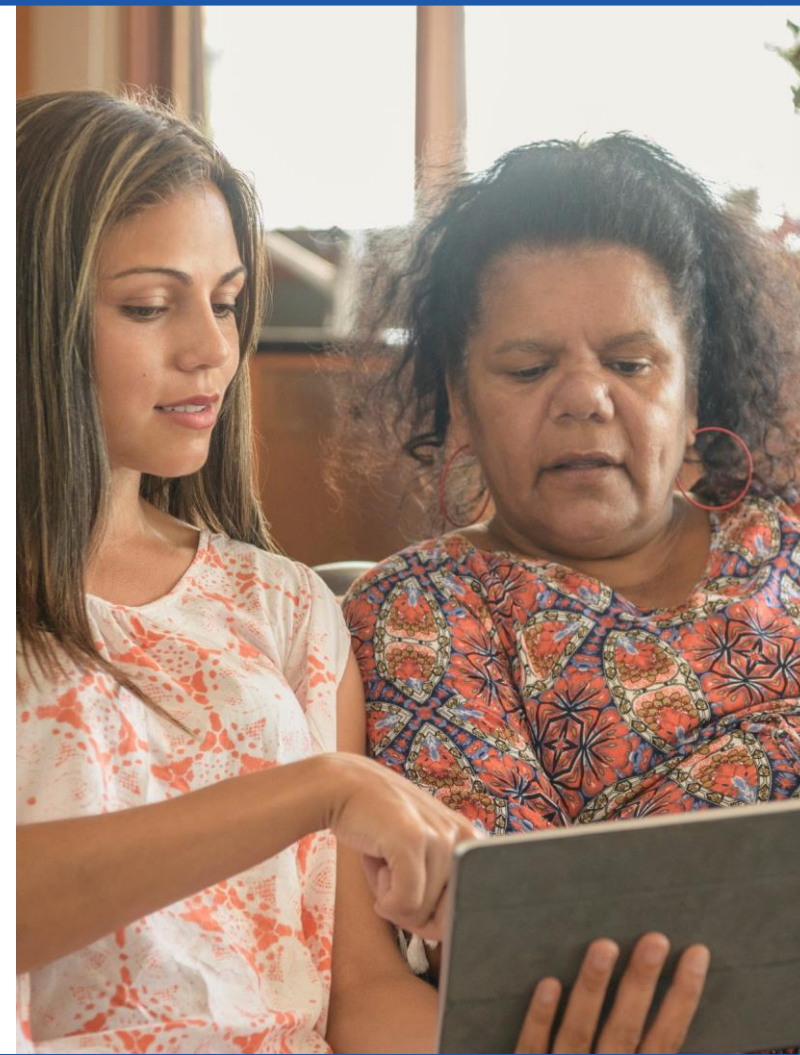

The Salvation Army Port Augusta Homelessness Service works alongside adults and families experiencing or at risk of homelessness by providing onsite, at home and street-based case management.

We aim to

Prevent homelessness through early intervention strategies

Reduce the length of time someone is homeless or in unsuitable accommodation

Prevent future homelessness by helping people regain stability

How can we help you or someone you know?

We provide the following services:

- Early intervention prevention support
- Crisis accommodation
- Intensive responses for people with complex needs
- Holistic case management onsite, at home and street-based
- Support to increase independence, community-based connections and recovery
- Support with advocacy
- Information and referrals to other services and resources including medical, drug and alcohol recovery, legal, financial, food, emergency aid and household services
- Assistance with housing applications and transfers
- Assistance with finding and/or maintaining stable accommodation

The Salvation Army recognises that the experience of homelessness is traumatic, and that once someone has had one experience of homelessness, they are at increased risk. We therefore work to ensure that any experience of homelessness is short and quickly resolved.
