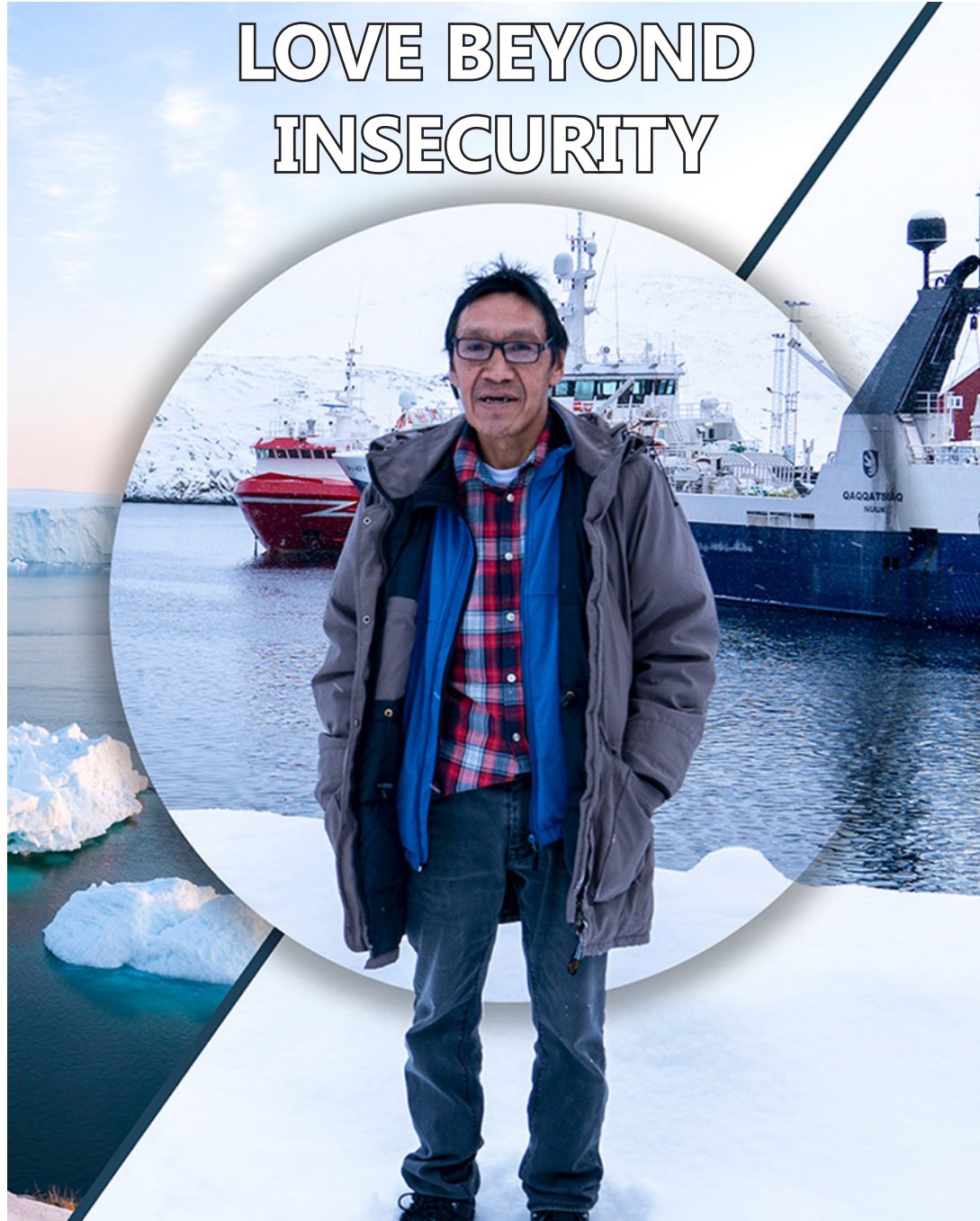

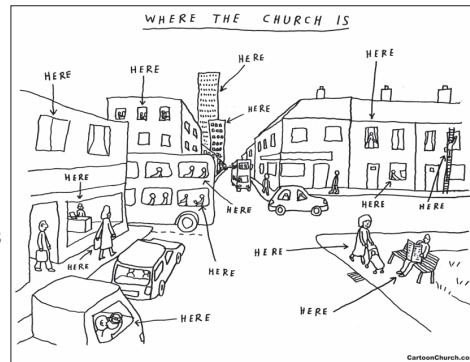
We are the Church
