

Hand Painted Plates



Simple plates that can be made for Mother's Day this year. All you need are ceramic plates and permanent markers.

Draw design on the plates and then place in a cold oven and turned the heat up to 180 degrees C (if you put them in to a hot oven the sudden change in temperature can cause them to crack).

After about 40 minutes, turn off the oven and let the plates cool completely in the oven. Some of the colours may change a little (they may get lighter or darker). Although the design is meant to be permanent, we recommend "Hand Wash Only".

Great so kids can present their mum with breakfast in bed.
