Tissue Paper Candle Craft



These paper napkin candles have got to be one of the easiest paper crafts ever. Some plain old white candles from the Reject Shop or Kmart etc can be embellished with tissue paper, and the results are stunning. Just follow the easy directions below. It takes less than 10 minutes to create this project.

Supplies needed:

- Tissue paper or patterned paper napkins (top printed layer only of napkins)
- Candle (white or light colour is preferred)
- Hair dryer or heat embossing tool
- Scissors
- Wax paper
- Pins

Instructions:

Cut tissue paper or paper napkins into strips or shapes with scissors.

Attach the tissue paper or paper napkins around the candle and secure with a pin

Wrap a piece of wax paper around the entire candle over the top of the tissue or paper napkin

Heat with a hair dryer or embossing tool. When the wax paper gets a shiny look move to another spot on the candle. Continue until the whole candle surface has that wet shiny look.

Remove wax paper and pins

Your beautiful candle is now ready for use

A word of warning: Always use common sense when burning candles. Never leave a burning candle unattended.
