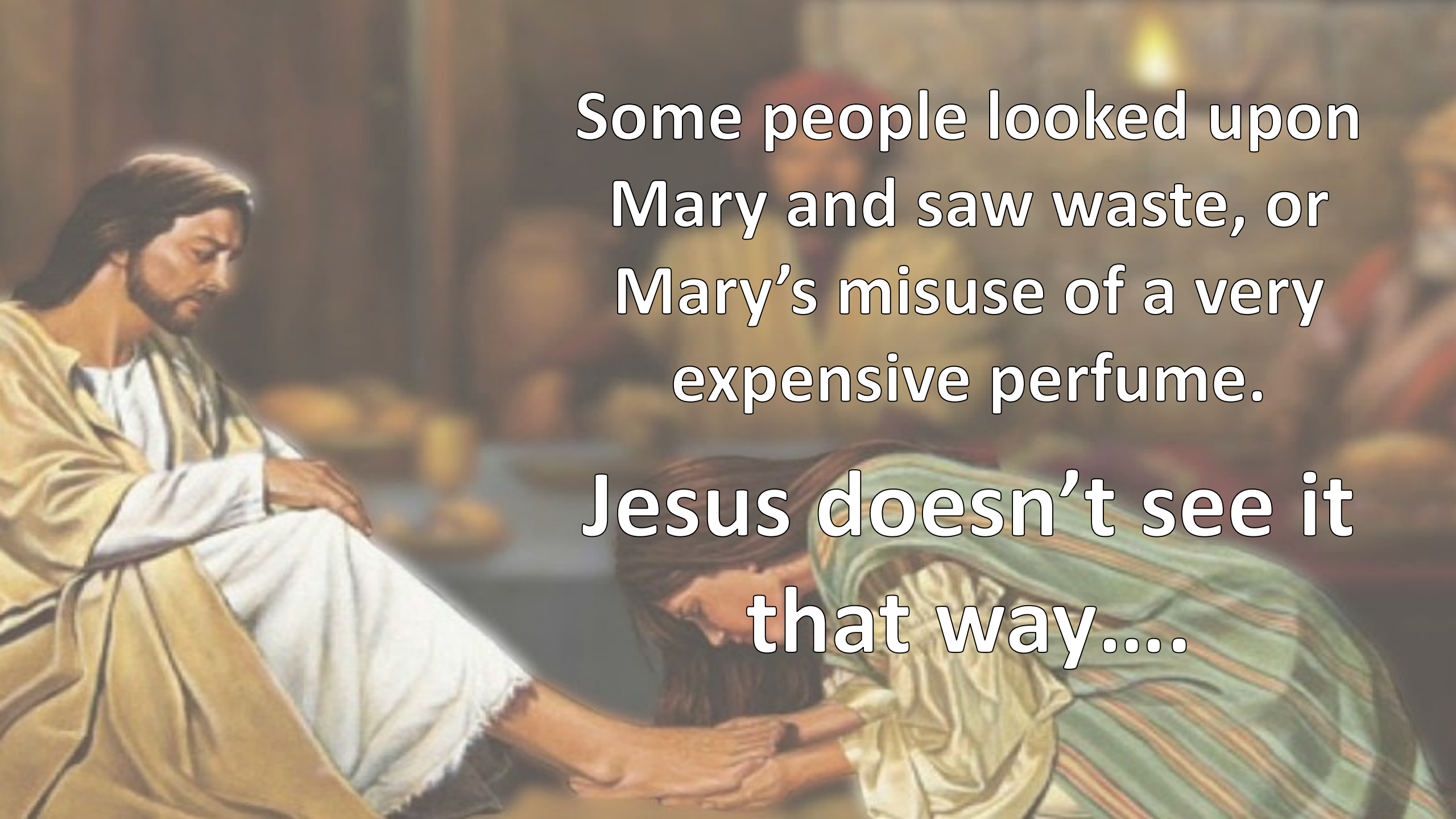


What we see when we look upon Mary is enough to raise our eyebrows and widen our eyes in disbelief...

the observers' attention!

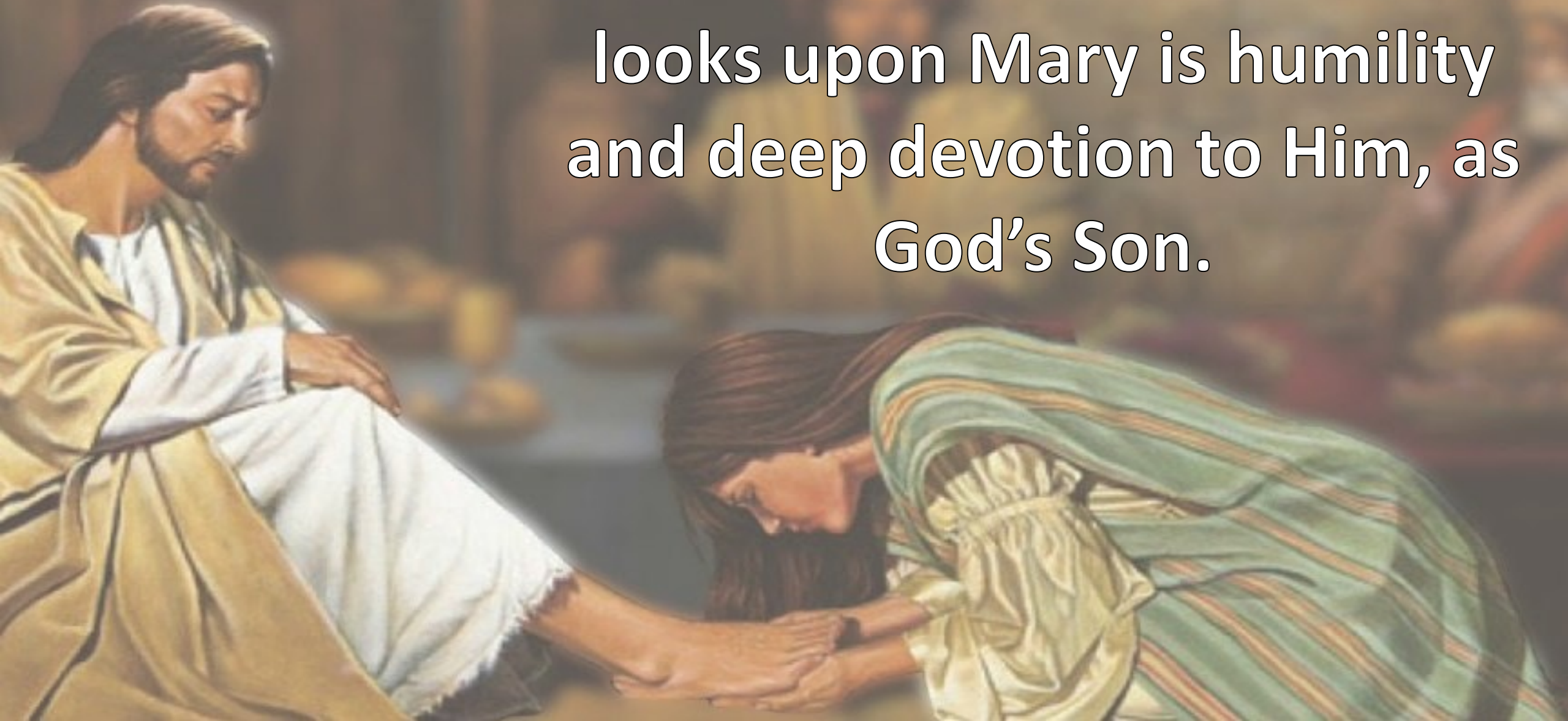


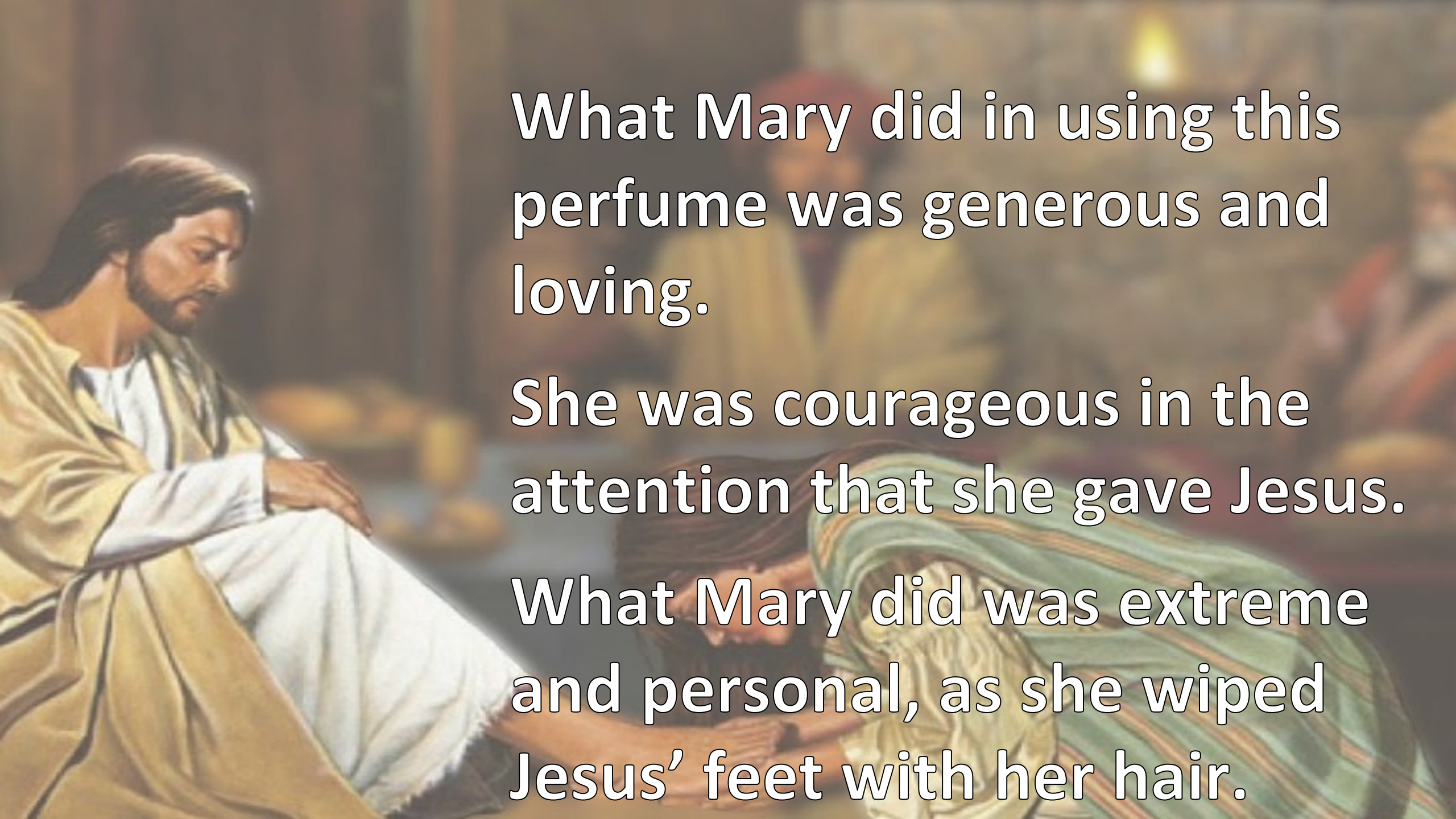


Some people looked upon

What Mary did in using this perfume was generous and loving.

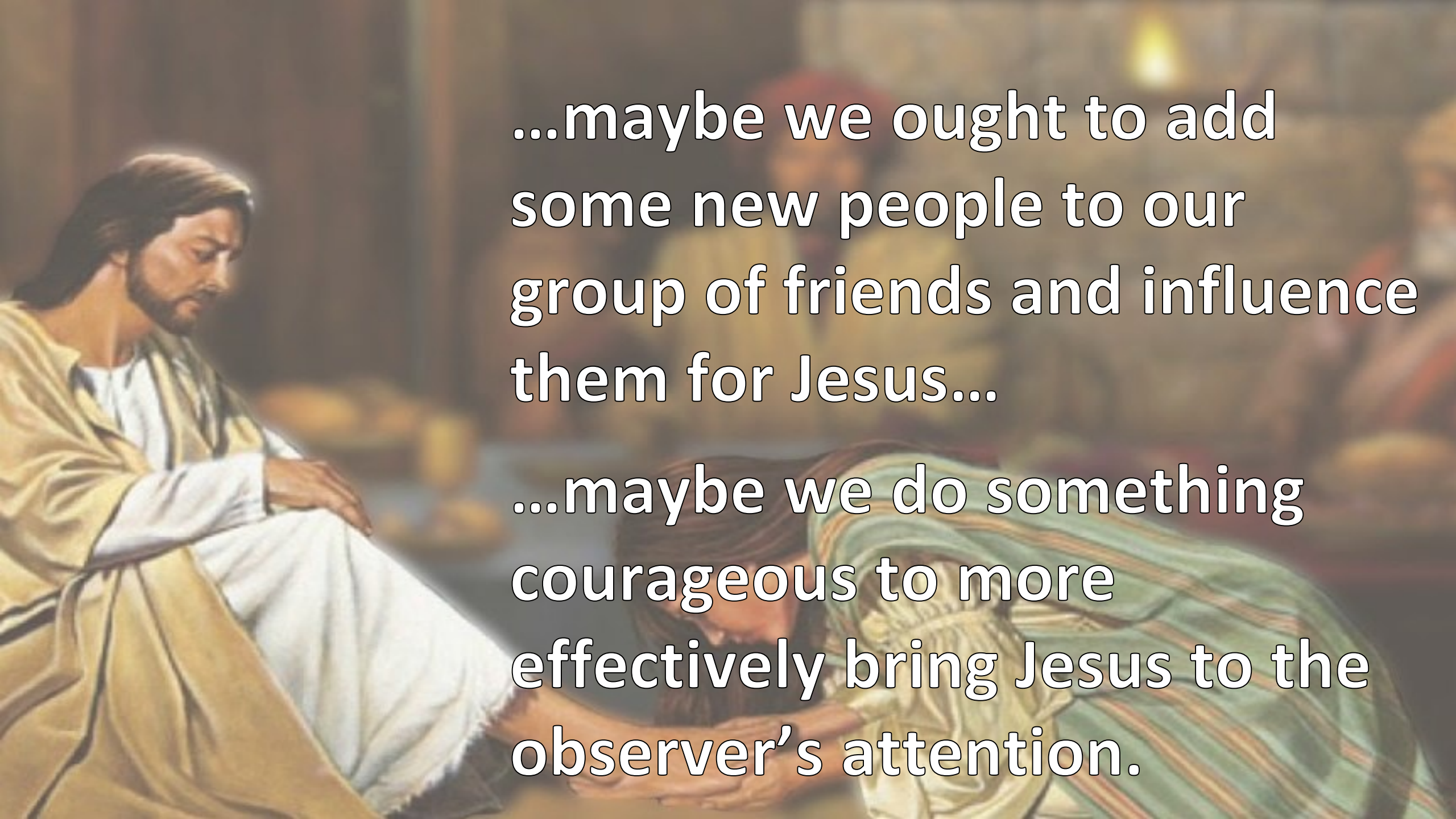
She was courageous in the attention that she gave Jesus.

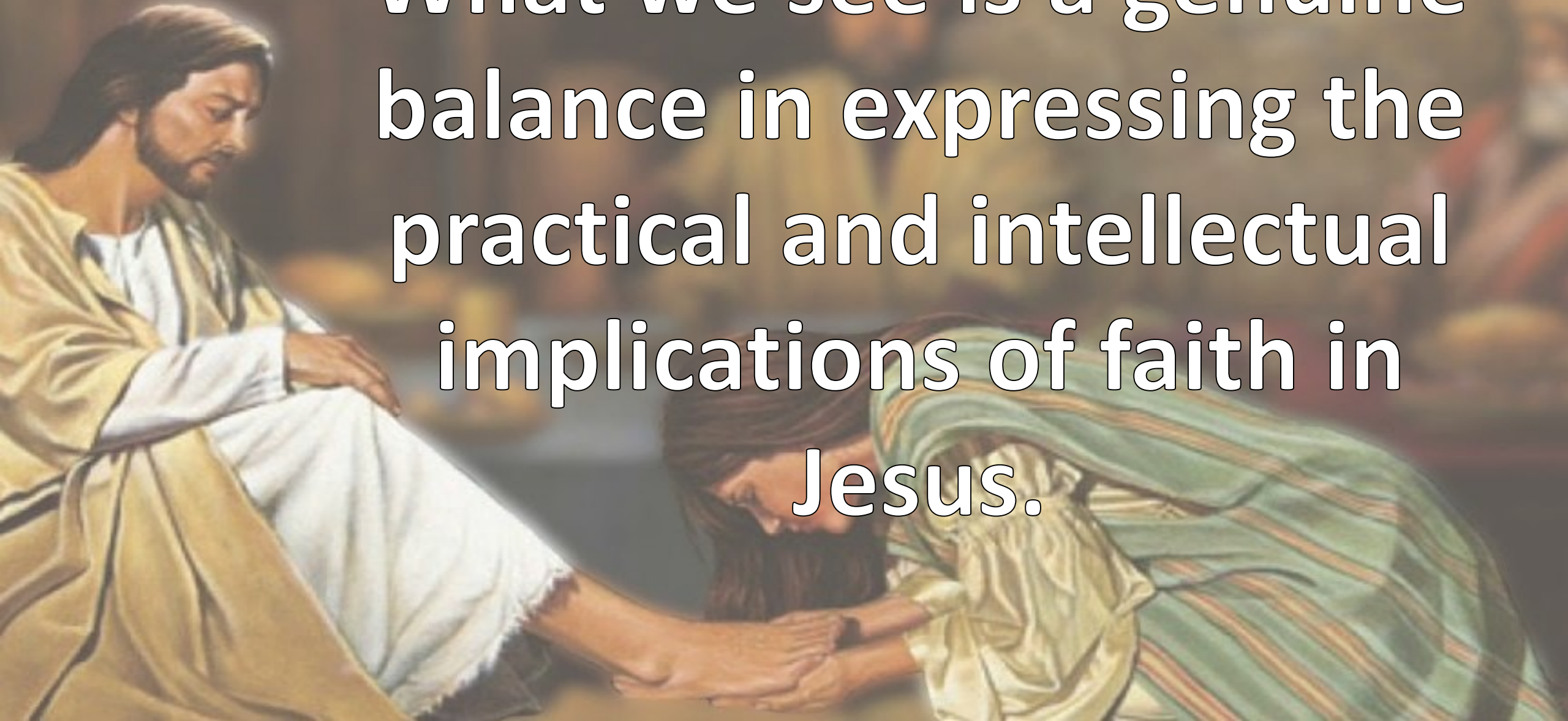

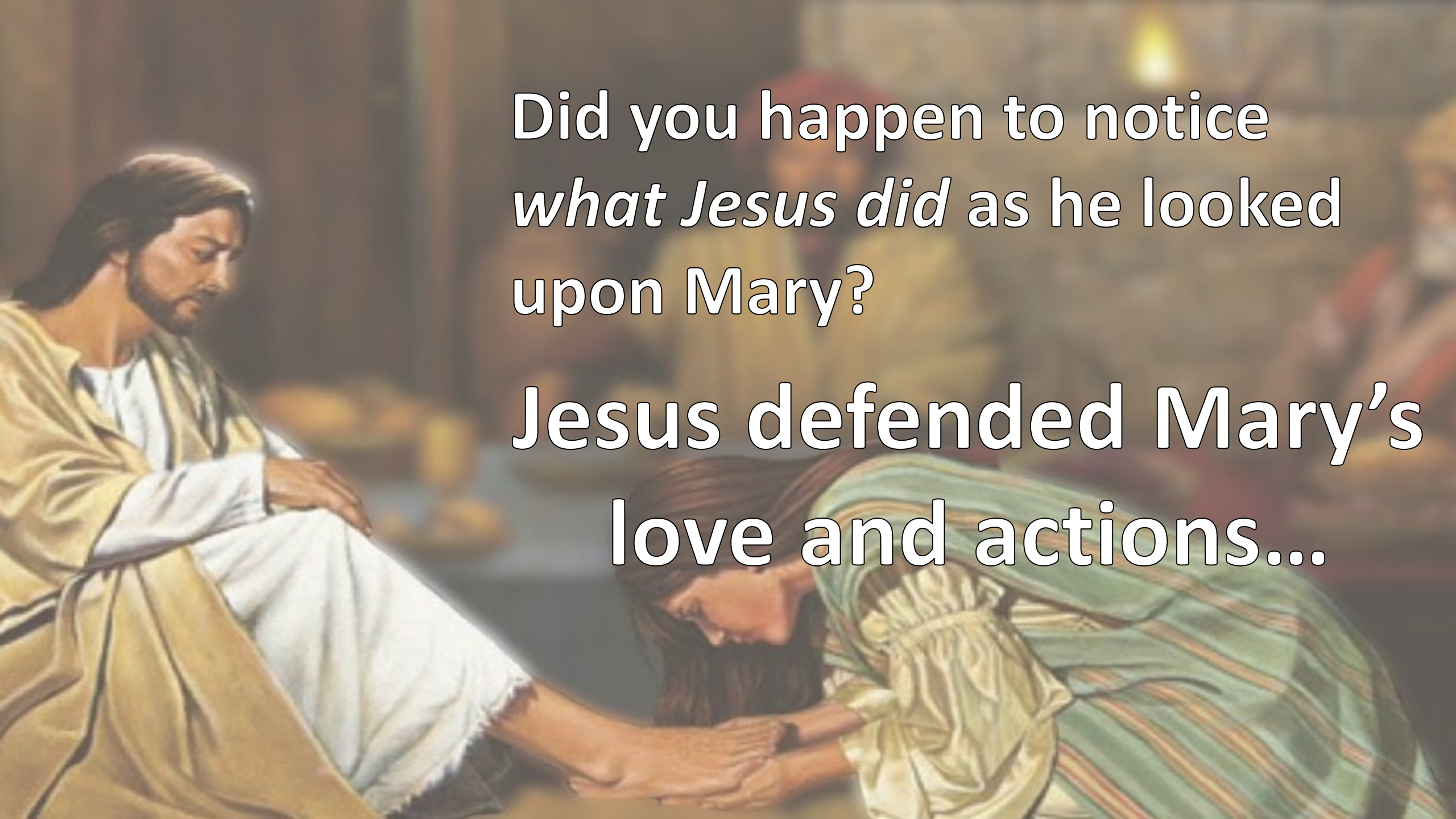

What we see is a genuine balance in expressing the practical and intellectual implications of faith in Jesus.

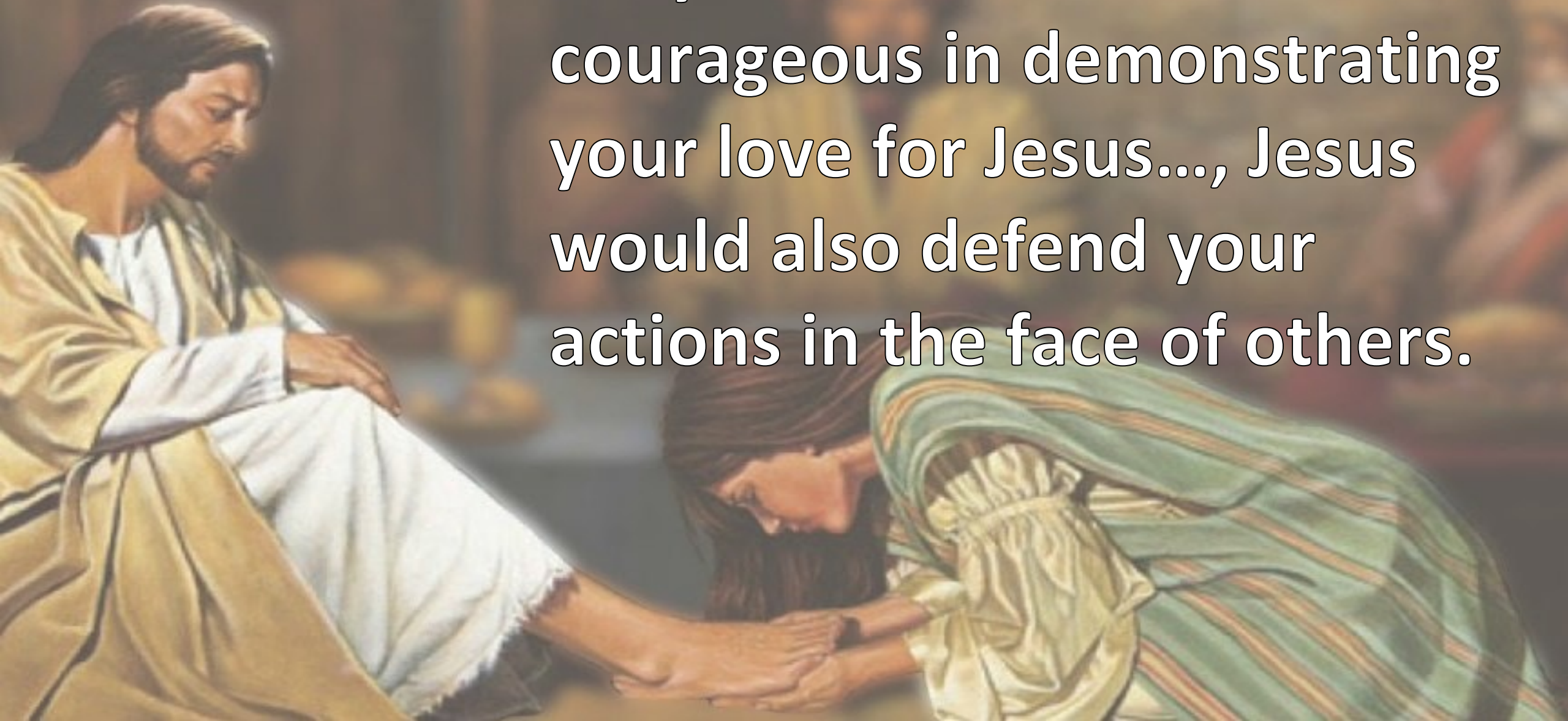


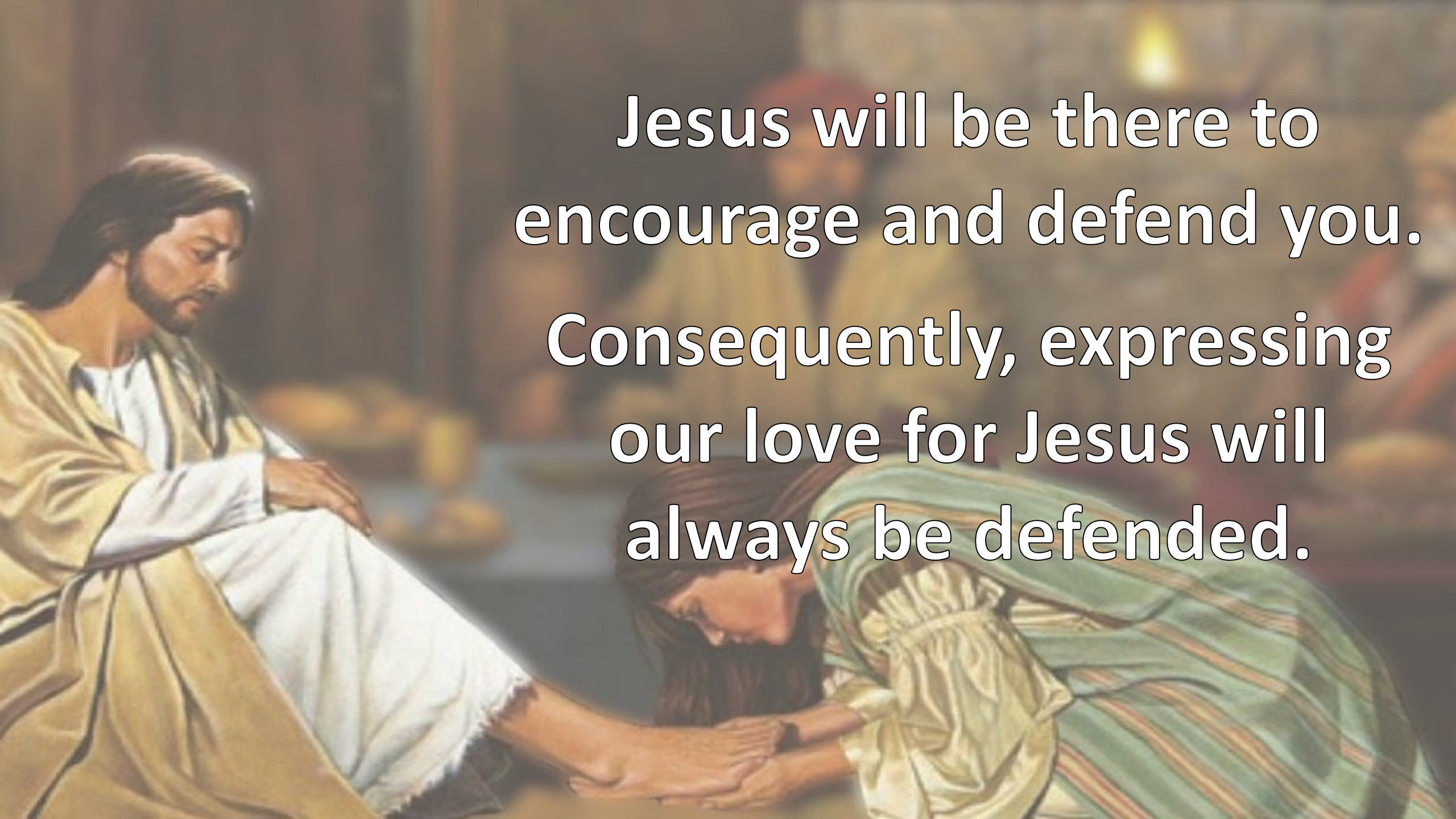

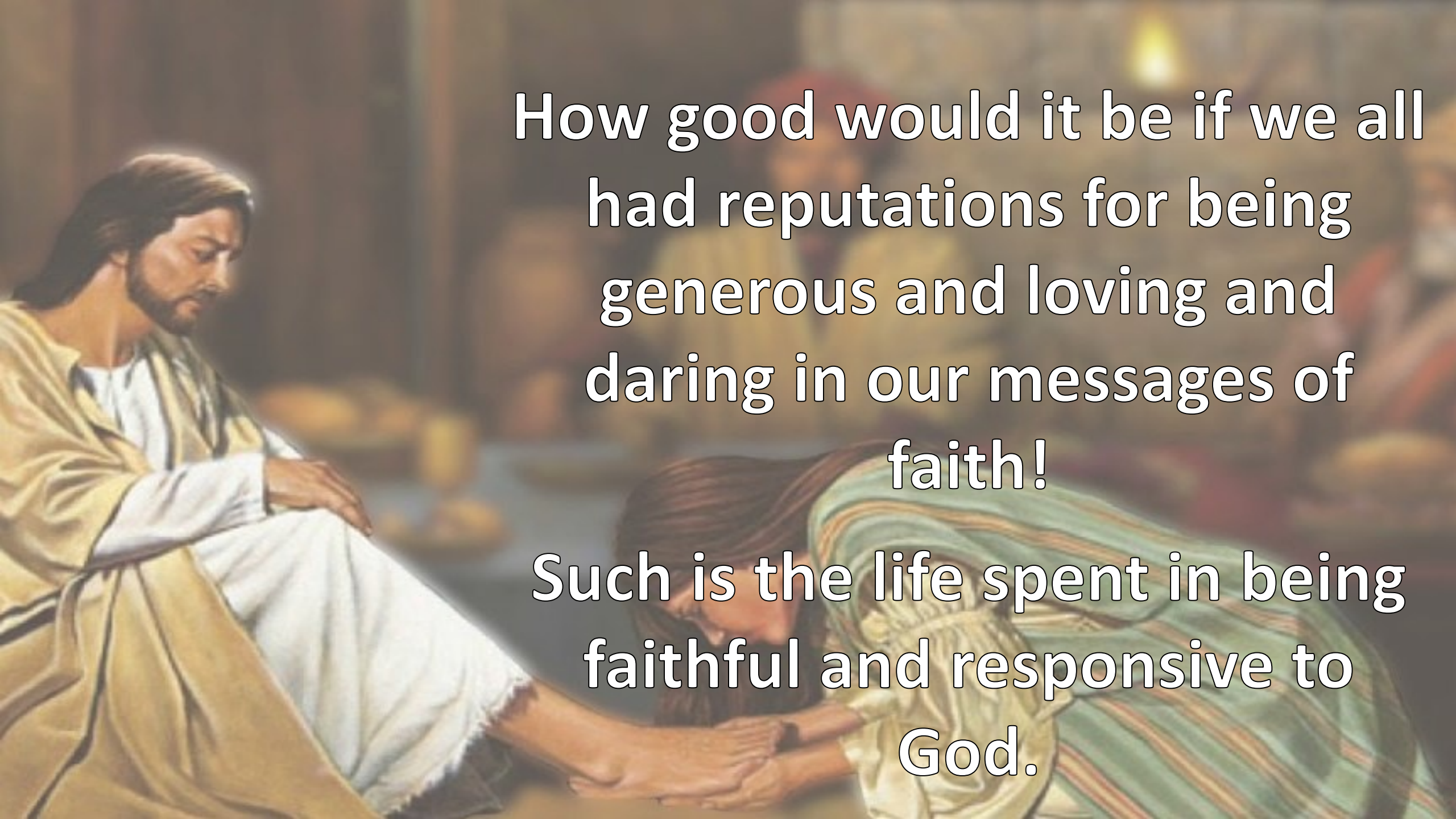
Jesus defended Mary's

Jesus will be there to encourage and defend you. Consequently, expressing our love for Jesus will always be defended.



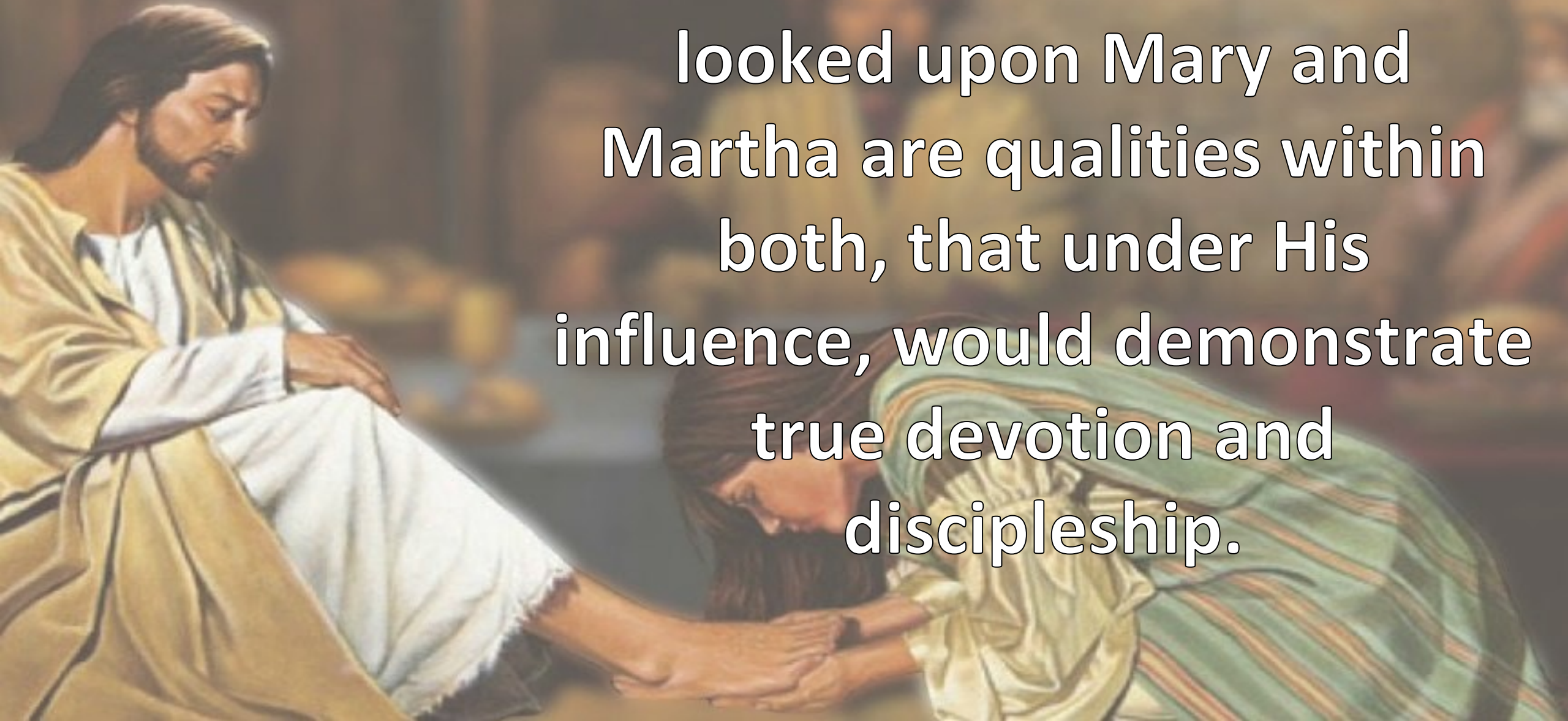
How good would it be if we all

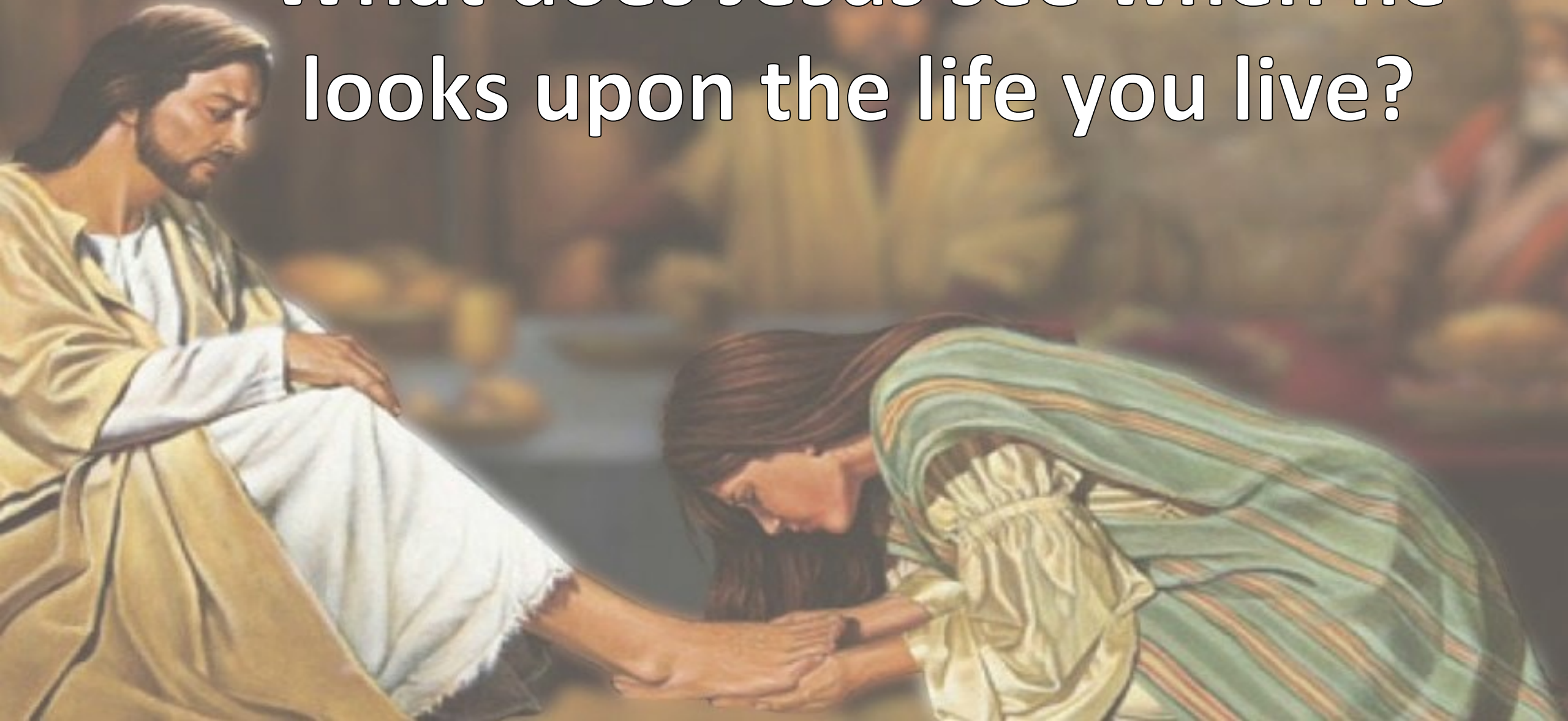
Mary and Martha teach us to use our resources wisely and to keep our eyes focused on what's important – Jesus.


