Romans 12:1-2

Ephesians 4:21-24

Are you being Conformed?

- The first challenge for us is to check if we are subtly being conformed to this world
- Paul was writing to a church that was at the centre of the Empire
- Excess, extravagance and immorality were the societal norms

Do not be conformed to this world (NRSV)

Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world (NLT)



Are you being Conformed?

- So what are the patterns of this world?
 - Self is more important than others
 - Wealth is more important than charity
 - Even when we are talking about spiritual things it is “my spirituality”
- As a young man I realized the pressure to conform often came because my lifestyle challenged theirs
 - Unfortunately, there were a number of times when I gave in
 - But praise God, His grace meant that I did not need to stay defeated



Or are you being Transformed?

*let God transform you into a new person by
changing the way you think (NLT)
but be transformed by the renewing of your minds (NRSV)*

- Are you asking the Holy Spirit to help you think like Jesus?
- How can we love the world when we are not to conform to the world?



Clothe ourselves with the thoughts and attitudes of Jesus

Since you have heard about Jesus and have learned the truth that comes from him, throw off your old sinful nature and your former way of life, which is corrupted by lust and deception. Instead, let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes. Put on your new nature, created to be like God—truly righteous and holy. (NLT)

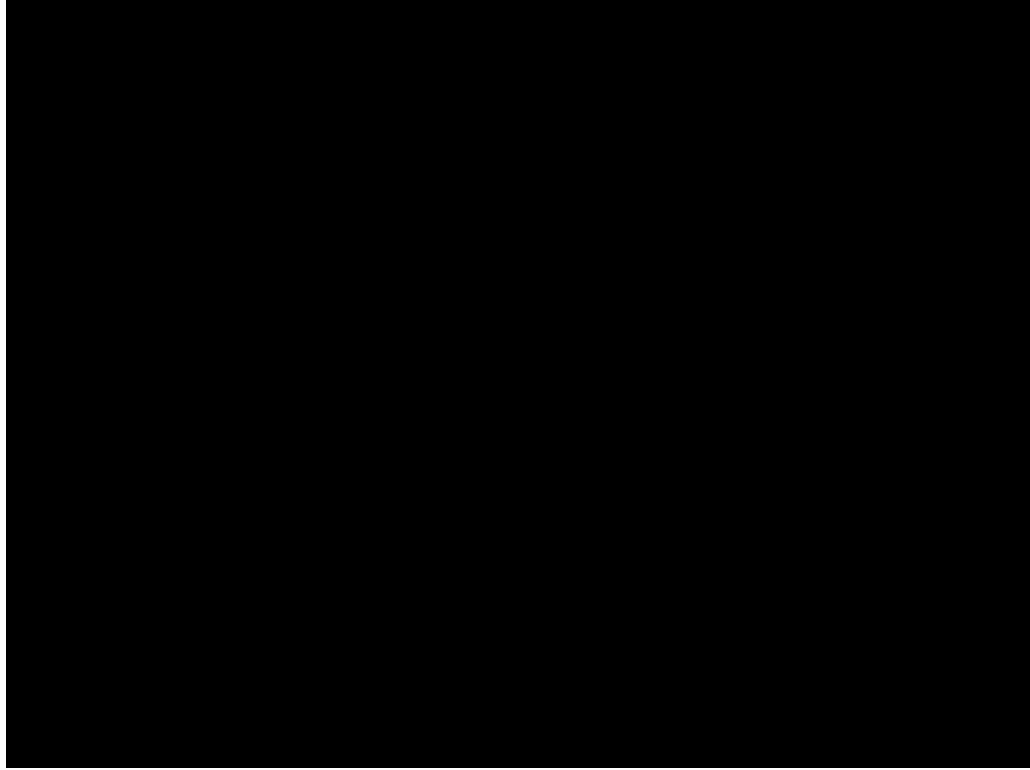

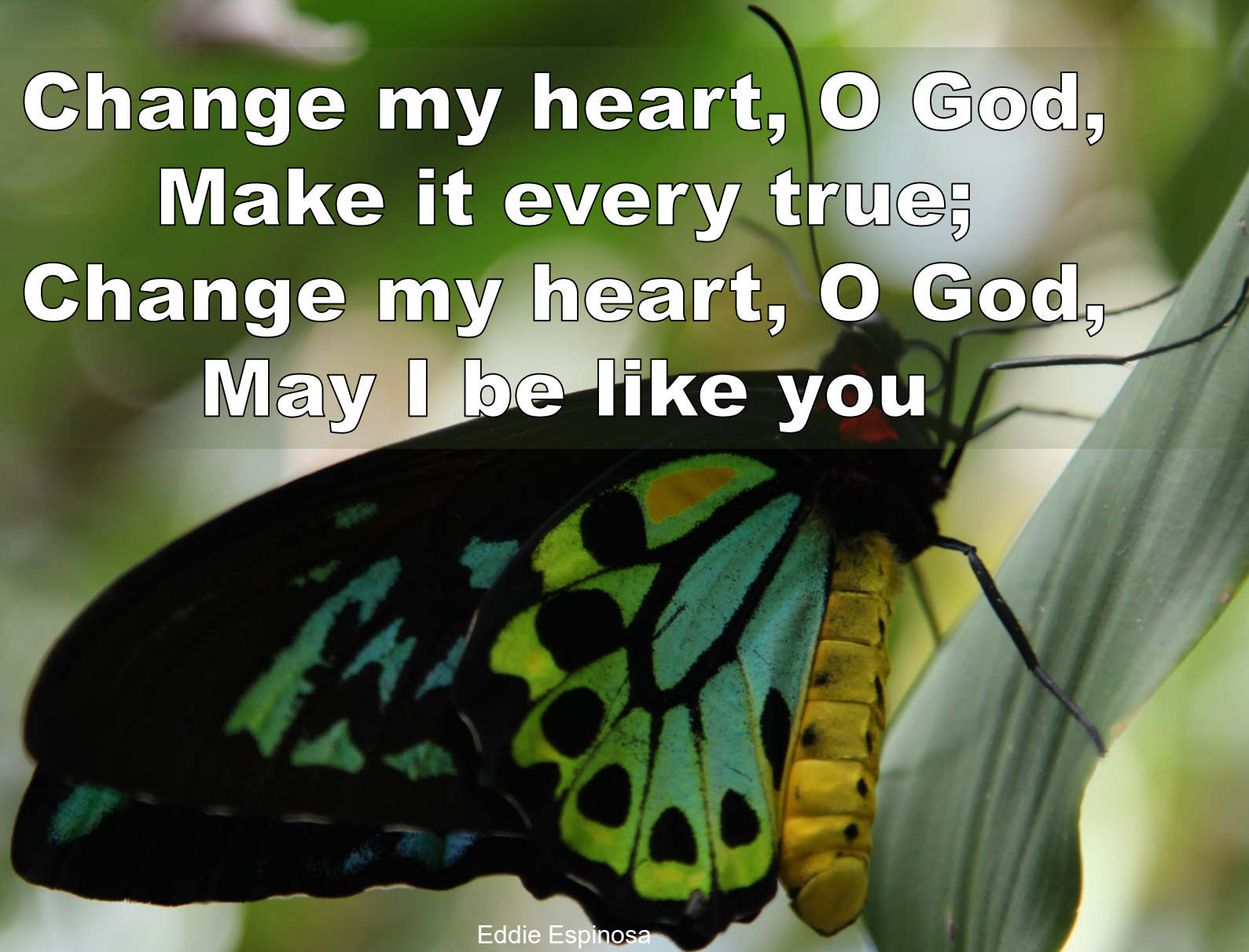

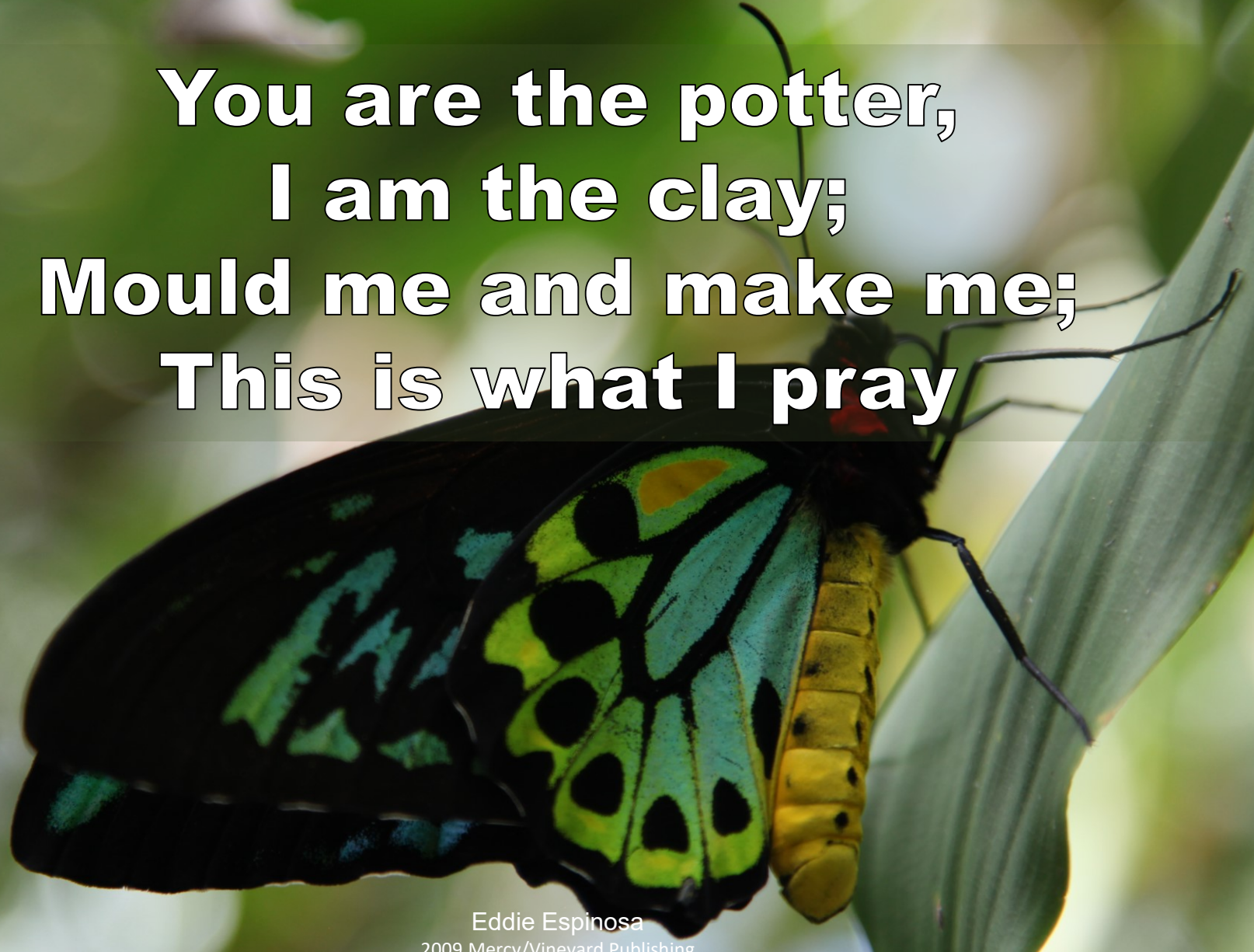
