Unity in the Body

- ⁴ Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God. ² Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love. ³ Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace. ⁴ For there is one body and one Spirit, just as you have been called to one glorious hope for the future.
- ⁵ There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism,
- ⁶ one God and Father of all,
- who is over all, in all, and living through all.
- ⁷ However, he has given each one of us a special gift through the generosity of Christ. ⁸ That is why the Scriptures say,
- "When he ascended to the heights,
 - he led a crowd of captives and gave gifts to his people."

- ⁹ Notice that it says "he ascended." This clearly means that Christ also descended to our lowly world. 10 And the same one who descended is the one who ascended higher than all the heavens, so that he might fill the entire universe with himself. ¹¹ Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers. ¹² Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do his work and build up the church, the body of Christ. 13 This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God's Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ.

The building...

Christian life is built on the foundation which Christ himself has laid! (1 Corinthians 3:11).

...we are both [Paul and Apollos] God's workers. And you [Corinthians] are God's field. You are God's building. 1 Corinthians 3:9.

The building...

You are God's building! Indeed, wherever you are, Christians are God's building.

The temple of God...

...a living building that grows increasingly into the sanctuary in which God's Spirit lives.

The building...

Don't you realize that all of you together are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God lives in you? 1 Corinthians 3:16 (NLT)

The building...

The Corner Stone of the building.

The inference being - from this point [Jesus] the spiritual equivalent of square, plumb, and level are determined.



II The seed...

...the Christian potential for love, service, and sacrifice, is sown into the soil of people's hearts. (Matthew 13)

...the sowing of the children of God back into the world (Matthew 13:38) where they in turn are to take root, grow, and bear fruit.

II The seed...

I planted the seed in your hearts, and Apollos watered it, but it was God who made it grow.

1 Corinthians 3:6 (NLT).

It is God who makes us grow.

God has planned for a crop and a harvest.



III The child...

Christians are portrayed as being born "a second time" (John 3:4) and becoming infants in Christ Jesus. (see Ephesians 4:13b-15).

III The child...

The Corinthian Christians' behaviour was contrary, and they had infant-like dependence upon human lessons (1 Corinthians 3:1).

III The child...

I had to feed you with milk, not with solid food, because you weren't ready for anything stronger. And you still aren't ready [for anything stronger] 1 Corinthians 3:2 (NLT)

III The child...

Sadly, the growth of many of God's children gets stalled by the things around them...

Some social media...

Half-baked or manipulative examples of love and truth...

A takeaway or bit diet of God's Word...

III The child...

We praise the almighty for leading us in his image and character as we grow spiritually!

III The child...

IV The disciple...

...an educational metaphor, rich in meaning, direction, and progress.

The purpose of discipleship was not merely the transmission of lessons (truths), it was about the transformation of the disciple.

IV The disciple...

... Jesus said, "Can one blind person lead another? Won't they both fall into a ditch? Students are not greater than their teacher. But the student who is fully trained will become like the teacher. Luke 6:39-40 (NLT)

IV The disciple...

When the disciple is fully trained....

Jesus said, the disciple "will be like his teacher" (Luke 6:40)

IV The disciple...

Discipleship is an imitation process meaning...

- being mended
- transformed from broken to completeness
- growth and growing.

Spiritual growth occurs when the willing cooperates with God.

We are God's workmanship

(Ephesians 2:10).
