- If you are asking people to post on social media, be aware of photo permissions and what is appropriate.

Minimal, less than a couple of hours.

Tips:

- Make the item unique and fun! Use a garden gnome, a toy dinosaur or event a piñata!
- Include hints and tips in your sessions.
- Have prizes to encourage participation.

Minimal.
